Bloom in Your Own Season

ONCE UPON A TIME there was a spring season when the Jonquils popped out of the ground and, as usual, bloomed before all of the other flowers. But this year they made fun of the other flowers which were just beginning to send their green shoots into the air. "Look at us with our golden blooms!" yelled the Jonquils. "You Tulips and Iris and Chrysanthemums are nothing. We have beautiful blossoms and you are just some insignificant foliage."

But one day Jonquils lost their blooms, just about the time the Tulips were beginning to flower. The Tulips, having had their fill of all the bragging done by the Jonquils, had to have their say. So they did the same thing to the other flowers. "Look at the glory of our colors." they said to the Peonies and Lilies, "You can't do this. You are nothing."

At the end of the summer the Chrysanthemums made their fantastic appearance with amazing colors. They screamed at what was left of the other plants, "You are nothing but 'has beens.' We are the greatest."

Of course flowers do not do this but we as human beings do it all the time. People are like flowers. Some bloom early and some bloom late, yet our culture wants everyone to bloom at the same time. It expects that at a certain age all must think and act like a given norm. All five-year-olds or all thirty-five-year-olds or all seventy-five-year-olds must conform to the same textbook image. We have not learned the lesson of the flowers.

It's not very appropriate for those who are in bloom to criticize those who are not. Nor does it do any good to scoff at those who no longer can show the talent and the beauty of another time. The greenery of the plants have their own majestic beauty even when there is no flower.

God gives individual gifts and at different times to each of us. This is the way we see His creation. If all of the flowers were identical and they all bloomed at the same time it would be a dull world.

So it is with people.

SECOND TROOP CAVALRY, FIRST SQUADRON
LOUISIANA STATE MILITIA, DeSOTO PARISH

During the early years of this century, robbery and murder were common occurrences on the roads of the North Louisiana country uplands. It was necessary to maintain law and order on these roads by the use of the State Militia. Most of the militia companies in these years were cavalry companies. The Second Troop Cavalry from DeSoto Parish was used to maintain law and order on the Natchez Trace West, from Natchitoches to Vidalia, LA, on the Mississippi River. credit to the State Militia.

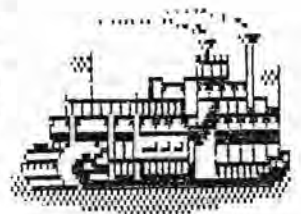

PURCHASING A STEAM BOAT
Natchitoches Parish, Louisiana

October the twenty eighth Anno Dominio Eighteen Hundred and thirty four, We the undersigned citizens of the town and parish of Natchitoches, do hereby agree to constitute ourselves into a joint stock company for the purpose of purchasing and running 2 Steam Boats in the Grade from this place and New Orleans and agree to pay the several sums annexed to our names, for said purpose. We further agree that the ??? of said funds and boats shall be confided to a President and four Directors to be elected by the vote of the stock holders so soon as a sufficient sum or amounts of stock can be subscribed. Each share of one hundred dollars to have one vote in the election for officers. The stock to be paid say one fourth part in hand, one fourth in four, one fourth in eight, and one fourth in twelve months from the time of the purchase of the boats.

Minutes:

Thirtieth Annual Meeting of Pilgrim's Rest Association of Primitive Predestinarian Baptists was held with Bethel Church, Lawrence County, Arkansas, on September 15, 16 & 17, 1899.

Friday Proceedings:

The Association met pursuant to adjournment with Bethel Church. Introductory sermon was preached by Elder W E RAGAN from the tenth chapter of the Acts of the Apostles. The Association was called to order by Bro. W G MATHENY, moderator, prayer by Bro. P O PORTER. The Association being organized elected Bro. W G MATHENY, moderator, and Bro. S J GALLOWAY, clerk...The moderator appointed a committee of 3 to-wit: S J GALLOWAY, Albert GOAD and J D RAGAN to arrange business for Saturday. Moved that the moderator appoint a committee of 5, to-wit: S J GALLOWAY, J C BILBREY, M M MONTGOMERY, A J THOMPCKINS and J D RAGAN to fill the pulpit on Saturday and Sunday with ministers.. The circular letter written by Elder J D RAGAN was read, received and ordered printed with the minutes...

Saturday's Proceedings:

Called to order by the moderator. Prayer by Bro. W E RAGAN... Agreed to continue our correspondence with sister associations and appointed W E RAGAN to write a corresponding letter to Bear Creek Association and that Bros. W E RAGAN and J D RAGAN bear said letter to above named association. Agreed to continue our union meeting and to hold the same with Shiloh Church at West Plains, MO commencing on Friday before the 3rd Sunday in July 1900. Agreed to hold our next association with Poke Bayou Church Sharp County, AR, commencing on Friday before the 3rd Sunday in September 1900...Elder P O PORTER was appointed to write a circular letter to be presented at our next meeting. Elder P O PORTER was appointed to preach the introductory sermon at our next association and Elder J T WINCHESTER as alternate...

HISTORY OF THE WILEY WEEKS FAMILY
Compiled by Jack HADNOT and John CUPIT



According to census records, Wiley WEEKS was born in Georgia in 1798 and his wife Delila, 1797, also GA. In 1820, he was living in Pike county MS together with John C WEEKS, William WEEKS & James WEEKS, Sr & Jr. It is thought that the WEEKS were likely to have been seamen. In NC, our research shows that some of the WEEKS from MA bought land in Onslow county and stated that they were sailors. It is also found that Levi WEEKS came from MA to MS and was the designer of the public buildings of Natchez, MS. He later settled near New Iberia, LA and build his home, the famous Shadows, there. Family tradition states that Wiley WEEKS' mother was a Scott and that she was born aboard a ship on the way from Ireland to America. She supposedly married a WEEKS who was part Cherokee Indian, called "Rippin Jim, the Georgia Stag." Wiley WEEKS was a Methodist preacher and is buried at Bryans Chapel Cemetery near Burke, TX. Delila WEEKS is buried at or near Kennedy, TX.

Children of Wiley & Delila WEEKS:

1. James A WEEKS-born ca 1821 MS, marr 1st: Lucy Ann WADE and 2nd Martha COX, lived in Sabine parish LA and was Clerk of the Court there in the 1860's.
2. Benjamin Franklin WEEKS-born Dec 1821 MS, marr Lydia GARLAND dau of Erasmus Hamilton GARLAND. Lydia died 23 Aug 1888 and Benjamin died 7 Jan 1906 in Vernon parish, LA.
3. Charles M WEEKS-born 1825 MS, marr Elizabeth GARLAND, another dau of Erasmus Hamilton GARLAND. Elizabeth was born in AL 1830. Charles was killed in what is now Vernon parish, LA the early part of August 1851, in what has been locally called the "Rawhide Fight."
4. Mary A WEEKS-born 1827 MS, married Martin CRAGER.
5. Jephtha H WEEKS-born 1827 MS, died in Sabine parish, LA during the Civil War. He was never marr, and at one time was Deputy Clerk of Court, Sabine parish.
6. Wiley Felix WEEKS-born 1830 MS, marr 1st Sarah Ann MARTIN 3 Mar 1857; marr 2nd Laura McNEELY, dau of Andrew Jackson McNEELY. Laura had been marr to a Mr. DALLY.
7. Martha A WEEKS, born 1832 MS, marr John J FAIRCHILD.
8. Delila WEEKS-born 1834 MS, marr James CRAWFORD.
9. John WEEKS-born 1838 MS, marr Nancy E BASS in Newton, TX on 16 Nov 1860.
10. Henry WEEKS-born 1847 MS, no further record, perhaps he died as a child.

In the 1860 census, Wiley WEEKS was living with his son James A WEEKS, together with the younger children. Delila & Henry WEEKS were not on census, so I am of the opinion that they were dead. A marriage license issued to Wiley WEEKS to marry Tabitha THOMAS on 31 Jul 1864 at Many, Sabine parish, LA.

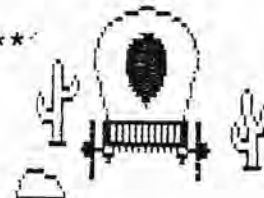

Henry F GOODNIGHT

The GOODNIGHTS came from KY & the father of our subject was named Henry also. He was a farmer & later in life moved to MO & died there. He was the father of James GOODNIGHT, who was born & reared in TN & was also a farmer & came to TX in 1849. He marr Elizabeth HELM in 1838. She was born & reared in KY. They had 7 children. Neither of the parents are now living. He died in 1854 & she in 1873 in Henderson co TX. Mr. GOODNIGHT himself was born in Marshall co KY 11 Nov 1844. He was educated in the common schools of Henderson co. He has been engaged in several varieties of commercial life, being now President of the Van Zandt County National Bank. He began to be a banker 2 Jan 1902. He served his city as Alderman for 5 years. In 1872 he marr Miss B H NALL of Howard co AR but who was a native of AL. They have 2 dau, one of whom is the wife of Dr. H T FRY. Mr. GOODNIGHT has lived in Van Zandt co for 26 years & came from Goshen, Henderson co. He came with his father to TX from KY in 1849. He is a member of the Christian Church & a Mason. He served in the Civil War, first as a privat, then as corporal. He was in the 34th TX Cavalry & engaged in the battles of Mansfield, Pleasant Hill & Yellow Bayou.

Dr. Marion Love COX

Born & reared in TX, the family came from AL. John COX was his grandfather. He was born in NC, but came to AL where he reared a family & where he lived & died. His vocation was that of farming. He was the father of Tillman L COX, who in turn was the father of our subject. He came to TX in 1853 & was one of the pioneers. He marr Nancy A RILEY who was born & reared in Talledega co AL & a sister to A J RILEY. They marr 25 Oct 1855. 10 children were born to them, 4 boys & 6 girls. Mr. COX died at Martin's Mill, TX 12 May 1888. Our subject was born 22 Feb 1870 & educated in the common schools, also the Alamo Institute & entered into the medical profession in 1893. He marr Mollie Hassell YOUNGBLOOD 12 Aug 1894. 2 children blessed this marr, a boy & a girl. The doctor is a Baptist & a member of the Woodmen of the World.

Judge Robert M LIVELY

The LIVELYs are from KY, Judge LIVELY's father was Rev. L P LIVELY, a Methodist minister, who preached a great deal in KY &

came to TX in 1864. Our subject was born 6 Jan 1854 near Fort Smith, AR. He moved with his father to TX in 1864. They first settled in Kaufman co. He began his law practice in 1876 & marr Julia CANNON on 27 Nov 1878. 4 children, 2 of each sex, complete his family. The Judge has served as county attorney in 1880-82, a member of the Methodist Church & W.O.W.

Cornelius Asberry MAYFIELD

The MAYFIELDS are Alabamians, Taladega co. They settled there in a very early day. The grandfather of our subject, Ephriam, with 2 brothers, Austin & Wylie, came to TX with their families in 1852. They were farmers. The eldest son of Ephriam was named Samuel Alexander & was born 1850 in the AL home, being only 2 years of age when the family came to TX. He marr Sarah DEAN & of the 7 children, 5 lived. "Neely" as he is familiarly known, is the 2nd son & was born 24 Dec 1875. He was educated in the county schools & began teaching at age 19. He is a member of the Red Men, W.O.W., & is a Mason.

James M WEEKS

Mr. WEEKS is a foreman on the T & P Railroad, beginning this work in 1883. He marr Agnes PONDER of MS on 19 Dec 1893 & they have 2 children: Marshall & Fern.

Robert E HIGH

He is the son of H H HIGH being born 27 Jan 1868 in TX. From farming, he drifted in the stock business, but later became a merchant. He has been county clerk & cotton weigher. He marr Eda B BATES 8 Jan 1888, also a TX native. They are both church members & he is a Woodman of the World.

Littleton DAVIDSON

Littleton DAVIDSON, born 15 Feb 1815, Thomas county GA, came to TX in an early day & attended schools here. Was a farmer and gin man for many years, then embarked in merchandising at Primrose, the firm being DAVIDSON & Son.

A J ADRIAN

A J ADRIAN's family came from GA in the early days. John David ADRIAN, his father, was one of the first citizens of Smith co & was one of the earliest representatives of that co to the legislature. He was also a charter member of the First Baptist Church in Tyler. In 1895 he marr Mrs. Sarah McADAMS & became the parents of 6 children. A J himself was born 20 May 1859 in Smith co & was educated in the common schools, but in 1882 went to Summerhill select school at Omen to become a druggist. In 1888 he marr Mary CHANDLER.

William O. WILLIAMS, M.D.

John WILLIAMS was born in SC but lived in AL. He was a tanner & grandfather of Dr. WILLIAMS. Warner WILLIAMS was his son & was born in AL & was a teacher. He came to TX in 1853. His mother was a McCOLLERS & was born & reared in GA. The father & mother were marr in 1832 & became the parents of 10 children. He died in Smith co TX in 1859 & she in Austin, TX in 1891. Dr. WILLIAMS himself was born in 1839 in AL but was educated in TX. He chose the medical profession early & graduated in medicine at the MO Medical College in 1880. He marr Miss M R STUART in 1875 & they had 4 children. Dr. WILLIAMS served in the Confederate Army in

DOUGLAS' TX Battery. He was a member of the Methodist Episcopal Church & the orders of A.F. & A.M. and I.O.O.F.

Elijah SULLIVAN

he is a son of Adam SULLIVAN, who came to TX from IL in 1839, settling first in Red River co. The elder SULLIVAN was the father of 11 children & died in 1867 at the age of 67 years. The children were: A.P., Harriet (Mrs. GILBERT), Cyrus, Milton, Eliza (Mrs. ALLEN), Adaline (Mrs. GIGER), Elijah, John, & Wellington (2 died in infancy). The SULLIVAN headright was excellent soil & in 1889 Mr. SULLIVAN made 70 bushels of corn per acre without fertilizer. He frequently made 1 bale of cotton to the acre, but his best record was 7 bales to 5 acres. Elijah was born 26 Feb 1841 in Red River co. The elder SULLIVAN built the school house & hired the teacher, Prof. WHITE to educate the children. Elijah marr in May 1865 to Miss Mattie HUFF & they were the parents of 10 children. She died 3 Sep 1886 & he marr Miss Estelle HILL on 29 Apr 1896, they had 2 daughters. He is a Cumberland Presbyterian & a Mason. He enlisted in Dallas as a Confederate soldier Jul 1861, Co G, 3rd TX Cav, ROSS' Brigade & was in the battles of WILSON'S Creek, Blue Ridge, Prairie Grove, Mansfield, Pleasant Hill, & many more.

John T. CURRY

His parents were English & immigrated to KY about 85 years ago. The father was a manufacturer of linen in England, but rope & bagging in KY. John T. was born 28 Oct 1837 in KY, one of 9 children, 6 boys & 3 girls. Young John was not in good health & was not sent to school. At 16 he was freed from parental restraint & labored in his brother's factory until he was 20 at \$8.00 per month. His education in books was limited; but his experience was ample. He always said he spent his whisky & tobacco money for books, and that's how he attained such a library. He marr Lizzie A McBRAYER 17 Jan 1861 also from KY. They raised 8 children & came to TX in July of 1879. Lizzie died 10 Jul 1887. He was honored by his countrymen in an election to the TX legislature 4 times. During those 8 years, he took not a drink of whisky, nor a chew of tobacco.

Dr. William Brutus WATKINS

The WATKINS family came from VA. They descended from a Welchman who came to VA in a very early day. John WATKINS was the father of our subject & was himself a physician & practiced his profession in Monroe & Conecuh counties in AL. Our Dr. WATKINS is one of 8 children, 5 brothers & 3 sisters. All 5 of these brothers were in the Confederate service. He was educated in the common schools & at the University of AL, then after the war, graduated from the university in New Orleans. He began his practice in AL but came to TX in Jan 1874. He marr Calodonia A. HARRISON on 16 Feb 1876, dau of Judge J. M. HARRISON. They had 4 children: Frank Hawthorne, William Brutus, Elizabeth Howard & Lillie Leake (who died as a child).

Randolph Macon SAMFORD

Mr. SAMFORD belongs to a large & influential family who came to AL at an early time. His grandfather, Thos. SAMFORD, was a Methodist preacher who was born in GA, but lived in AL &

ultimately came to TX & died in Jefferson. He was the father of William F Burleson SAMFORD, who was also born in GA but lived in AL for many years. He came to TX on a visit once but always lived in AL. He marr Susan L DONDELL, who was born in GA & partially reared in AL. They were the parents of 13 children. He died on the 11th of July, & the wife in Dec. Randolph was born 1854 in AL. He was educated in the A & M College in Auburn. He marr Katie R LOGAN of KY 3 Dec 1876, they raised 10 children. He is brother to William F SAMFORD, late governor of AL. He was Tax Assessor as well as County Clerk of Van Zandt co TX. Randolph comes from the families of BURLESONs, JONESes, GAGEs, KUYKENDALLs & TAYLORs, he was a Methodist, a Mason, an Odd Fellow & Woodman of the World.

Judge Thos. J FOSTER

The family came from VA, the grandfather being Thomas FOSTER, was born & reared in VA but moved to Wilkes county NC where he died. The family was a farming one. Ambrose FOSTER, father of our subject, was born & reared in NC & never came to TX. He marr Mary MILLER in 1818 & they raised 7 children. He died in 1832, she moved to TX where she died in 1878. The judge was born 15 Jun 1826 in NC & was educated there. He farmed in TX, then was elected County Clerk, then County Judge. He marr Frances A. TATE 20 Dec 1860, also served in the Confederate Army & served as 1st Lt & Capt. He was also a Mason.

William Austin Thomas MURREY

The MURREY family came from Murrey County TN. William was the grandfather & was born in TN but ultimately came to TX where he died. William Austin MURREY was his son & the father of our subject & was born in the TN home 23 Apr 1830, but was reared in TX. He marr Catherine POWDRILL who was born near Shelbyville, TN 18 Nov 1834 & came to TX in 1836. They married in Aug of 1856 & had 8 children. She died 27 Feb 1889, he died 8 Aug 1885, both in Myrtle Springs. Our subject was born 20 Aug 1859 in Cherokee county TX. He was educated in county schools & attended Wills Point High School, becoming a nurseryman & orchardist & also editor of the paper The Fruit Grower. He marr Ella BATEMAN 18 Nov 1885, she died 13 Sep 1886, & he marr 2nd Stella MILLS on 21 Sep 1888., she died 23 Aug 1899 & he marr 3rd Ella BULGIER on 18 Mar 1900. He fathered 6 children. He was a member of the Bankers' Union of the World, United Benevolent Assn of TX, the Farmers Union & the church. His orchard contained more than 1,000 fruit trees & more than 400,000 nursery trees & plants.

W.G. PAYNE

He was born in Smith county TX 14 Nov 1853 & was reared on a farm in the same place. He was the son of John H. PAYNE, a substantial farmer of that county. He marr Lina BELL & they were the parents of 4 children. Mr. PAYNE merchandised in his early life but later became a gin & mill man. He was a Mason & church member.

Dr. Thos. Porter DAVIS

He was the son of Charles C DAVIS & a grandson of Thos. C DAVIS. The family originally came from NC, but T.C. was born in east TN, but afterwards came to GA. He was a farmer & the son C.C. was born in the GA home & became a real estate man. He came

to TX in 1898. He marr Miss S A VARNELL, who was born & reared in GA, in 1857, & they reared 3 children. Dr. DAVIS was born in GA 6 Oct 1858 & received his literary training in that state. He attended Southern Medical College at Atlanta & graduated 26 Feb 1880 as the valedictorian of his class. He marr 23 Dec 1885 to Julia R KELLUM of Canton, TX & they had 3 children. He was a member of the Methodist Church, a Woodman of the World & I.O.O.F.

Elder Jordan William HOBBS

He was a grandson of William HOBBS, a son of Louis Harrison HOBBS & brother of Elder John R HOBBS. They were from AL & were a farming family. His father, Louis, marr Wincey SIDES 10 Jan 1838 in AL, coming to TX in 1850. They became the parents of 14 children. The father died 15 Jan 1874, the mother 25 Sep 1896, both in TX. Our subject was born 29 Jun 1850 in Talledega county AL, but was educated in the common schools of TX. He was a great reader & one of the best posted men in the history of Van Zandt County. He marr Josephine COOK 18 Jul 1872 & 2nd, Paralee WALTERS on 22 Feb 1876. He fathered 5 dau & 2 sons. He was a Baptist preacher & a farmer & a fine thinker & reliable citizen.

Christopher Calhoun GIBBS

The GIBBS family was Scotch-Irish, the elder GIBBS born in GA & reared in AL, where he marr Martha BREWSTER. About the year 1840, they came west & settled on the Sabine River in Panola county. The elder, Pulaski Floyd GIBBS, was a farmer & later a merchant. Christopher was born 22 Nov 1848 in the Panola home & hence is a Texas to the manor born. He was educated in the county schools but finished his course in Keachi Male High School in Keachi, LA. He taught for a few years but returned to the soil to farm. He marr Mary Jane GRAY on 25 Oct 1879 & raised 4 boys: Archibald Andrew, Ephram Wilford, Franklin Fisk & John Cullen (1 boy & 1 girl died young). He was a pioneer in raising the Spanish goober, with great successes.

Jacob Bradford LAWLER

The LAWLERS came from AL, Abner LAWLER was the grandfather & was born in TN. He moved to Talledega, AL & was a farmer. He was the father of Levi R LAWLER, who in turn became the father of Jacob. He was also a farmer but never came to TX. He marr a Miss ELROD, who was born in TN, but reared in AL. They were marr in 1849 & became the parents of 9 children. He died in GA in 1863 & she in AR in 1880. Our subject was born in Talledega, AL 12 Apr 1863 & educated in that state. He marr 1 Aug 1883 to Alice HOBBS & they had 8 children. He came to TX in 1880 from AL & was connected with the public business of the area in a number of ways. He was Constable from 1892 to 1896; then First Deputy Sheriff. He was a member of the Baptist Church, a Mason, a Woodman of the World & a Knight of Honor.

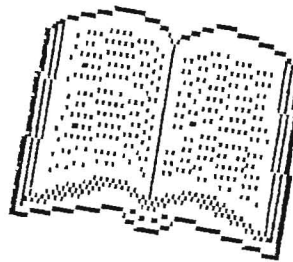
