This is an excellent service for new members and beginners. We are very pleased to be able to give this service to our patrons.

The vertical file has several additions. Be sure to check the State Envelopes for the states you are working in. There is much information available here.

Several rolls of Ohio microfilmed census records are on order and will be available for use in the near future.

The Central Genealogical Association is now sending us newspaper clippings from the "Town Talk" of Winston DeVille's column, En Passant.

"Glo-Quips", a Gloucester Virginia publication has been given to our collection by Mr. Charles Jennette. This small publication has an excellent column on the old families of Gloucester.

"The Ecoher", a West Virginia mimeographed genealogical publication is now available, thru the courtesy of Mrs. Enoch Norton.

The Genealogy Room of Shreve Memorial Library has received thirty-three volumes of notes from Mr. John Thomas Cupit of Rosepine, one of the ablest genealogist of Louisiana. We are very delighted to have received this gift from him. These unpublished notes of Mr. Cupit contain genealogical records of many allied families of his, notes on many families of Vernon Parish, and much miscellaneous information from other states. The Navarro County Courthouses. The first Navarro County courthouse was the home of W.R. Howe, 1846-48. Edward H. Tarrant was the first County Judge. W.B. M. Nicholson was district Clerk; R.N. White, County Clerk; Ethan Melton, treasurer, Elias Rogers, Tax Collector; Isie Cline, constable; James A. Johnson, sheriff; Thomas A. Ward, land commissioner. Later the county seat was moved to Corsicana. J.A. Johnson built the new courthouse in 1848 for \$150. The third Courthouse was built in 1851 by T.D. Haynes. It was destroyed by fire in 1855. The fourth courthouse was built in 1858 by J.M. Riggs. Since that time there have been two courthouses built to accomodate a growing area.

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MARRIAGE SKETCHES OF SOME EARLY CITIZENS OF CASS COUNTY, TEXAS

John C. Adams and Miss Sarah Mazingo were married 15 June 1870 in Alabama; moved to Cass County, Texas, 1873; settled in Springdale, northeast part of county.

A.A. Brabham and Miss Mattie Griffin married 22 December 1878. He came to Cass County in 1877 from Alabama. She came from Georgia. They lived in Union Chapel community, northwest part of Cass County.

W.R. Duck and Miss Callie Glaze married 24 January 1878 at the Union Hill Church in Cass County, Texas. They had nine children. Mr. Duck was born 1854; Mrs. Duck in 1861.

Mr. and Mrs. E. Eargle married 2 August 1874, near Cass in county of that name. They had ten children.

J.H. Frost and Miss Eufala L. Snipes married 6 January 1876, at home of bride's parents Mr. and Mrs. James H. Snipes, three miles east of Douglassville. The Frosts made their home in Union Chapel community, Northwest part of Cass county, Texas. Mr. Frost, born 1850, came to this county in Decmeber 1857, with his parents from Butler county, Alabama. Mrs. Frost, born 1854, came to this county in December, 1869, with her parents from Macon County, Alabama.

Reverend J.H. Hanson and Miss Mary Jane Larnear married in 1867 in Cherokee county, Georgia; moved to Cass County, Texas, 1885; settled near Bloomburg. They had six boys and six girls. Mr. and Mrs. Hanson both were born 1853. He was licensed as a Baptist minister at the age of twenty-two.

William A. Harris and Jo Anna Hays married 14 December 1876 in South Carolina. They came to Texas in 1887, and settled in Marietta in Cass County. Both, Mr. and Mrs. Harris were born at Fairplay, South Carolina, in 1853.

J. M. Herring and Miss Emma White married 7 February 1878, at Troy Alabama, came to Cass County, Texas 1885. They had seven children.

W. D. Wechel and Mildred Rice married in Georgia in 1874; came to Sppingdale Cass County, Texas, 1901. They had twelve children. Mr. Wechel was born in Georgia in 1853. Mrs. Wechel was born there 1858.

J.W. Wiley and Miss Sallie Ferguson married 12 June 1876 at Galliton, Tennessee. They moved from Kentucky to Lenden, Texas in February, 1885.
