

 ABLE FOR USE NOW. THIS IS NOT THE
 COMPLETE COLLECTION. THE FILMING OF
 THE MARRIAGE RECORDS IS NOT YET COM-
 PLETE. HOWEVER, BETTER THAN 900 ROLLS
 ARE HERE AND AVAILABLE.

Five rolls of the 1870 Texas cen-
 sus has been added. Cass County, Tex-
 as is now available in 1870 under the
 name Davis County. The name was changed
 at the time of the Civil War and then
 changed back to Cass shortly after the
 1870 census.

The new filming of the 1850 Miss-
 issippi census is on order and should
 be available in the very near future.

THE NATIONAL ARCHIVES IS IN THE PROCESS
 OF FILMING THE EARLY PENSION APPLICATION
 AND HAVE ISSUED LETTERS TO THE LIBRARY
 THAT PERSONAL RESEARCH IN THESE FILES
 WILL BE EXTREMELY SLOW IF NOT IMPOSSIBLE
 FOR THE NEXT FEW YEARS. HOWEVER, IF
 THIS FILMING IS MADE AVAILABLE TO US
 IT WILL BE A GREAT BOON.

 ARKANSAS WAS CENSUSED PRIOR TO 1880?
 SO FAR AS WE CAN FIND THIS IS THE ONLY
 CENSUS AVAILABLE.

 MYSTERY UP. "Abolished 1836 & returned
 to Arkansas Re-established 1874."
 Who returned it? No mention in the
 Bowie County, Texas records that it
 ever included Miller County. If anyone
 can help us with this, we would be
 most grateful.
