BOOK REVIEW

A DIRECTORY OF GREENE COUNTY FOR 1855-6, by Gayle Snedecor. This book is a 1963 reprint that was edited and indexed by FRANKLIN SHACKELFORD MOSELEY of Eutaw, Alabama. The directory gives the names of voters in the county, their occupation, residence and post office. In addition to this, a map is given with enough information to locate each of the voters. If the voter moved in to the area before 1824, his date of arrival is noted. Lists of churches and their ministers is included in the miscellaneous material of the book. The last half of the book is devoted to a sketch of the early settlers of Greene County. In addition to many names of the early settlers many clues about early families would help in locating the later settlers.

Books on Alabama have been scarce in our collection and this book, while small in size, is a large addition to the information available. The book is a gift of Mrs. Ema Tipton.

In addition to this book, we have added several others.

HOW DID YOU BEGIN YOUR RESEARCH?

In 1969 several people asked me how to begin genealogical research. Remembering my own beginning, I tried to help them and it has been a wonderful, happy year. Some books on this subject deal too lightly with the fact that most beginners have never seen a family group sheet, ancestor chart, census schedule, or old courthouse record. In fact, most beginners have never been inside a courthouse except to pay taxes, register to vote, or apply for a marriage license. Words and phrases familiar to experienced genealogists are often meaningless to them.

About five years ago I became interested in my family history and attended my first genealogical meeting. When I asked how to begin, a few members smiled, a few giggled, and a few tried to tell me, but they may as well have been speaking in "unknown tongues" because I understood little of what they said. Mr. Farrar gave me a few ancestor charts and family group sheets, which, to my inexperienced eyes, looked as complicated as a federal income tax form. Ben Achee showed me how to put a roll of microfilm on the reader and how to use it, but I was so sure no one could ever decipher that smudged, dingy gray cloud, I wondered why he bothered. It was one of those old illegible double-page 1870 census schedules and I assumed all the others would be just like it. This completed my formal initiation into the mysteries of genealogical research.

Desperate, I obtained a copy of Know Your Ancestors by Ethel Williams and read it through, non-stop, then over and over again until it began to soak in. Thus, I began - confused, discouraged, frustrated, almost hopeless, but too stubborn to quit. Today I'm still confused, discouraged, frustrated, almost hopeless at times, and still too stubborn to quit. Experience is said to be the best teacher, but it leaves too much to chance. For example, I never knew the importance of old Chancery Court Records until I accidentally stumbled over them this summer and found records on a family I had abandoned two years ago as lost forever. There should be a better, faster, less expensive way to learn, and we should share our off-the-beaten-track experiences in research with those who can benefit from them. Any seldom used or little known sources of information are important to all of us.

After five years of week-end and vacation research, I have an almost complete 5-generation ancestor chart, two or three additional generations on some lines, several hundred family group sheets, and four file drawers of family records, but if I had learned the basic techniques of research the first few months, I could have accomplished this in half the time.

Do you remember how lost you once felt in a group who talked of advanced research, State Papers, Territorial Records, etc. and more etc., and spoke of courthouse records as if they were as easy to find and read as full page ads in the newspapers? While you forlornly wished only that you knew the names of all your great-grandparents? Or maybe just one of them? And how to find them? I do!

New Year's resolutions are a waste for me. I break all of them by January 2. But, let's begin our New Year by helping some beginner begin. We should reach out our hearts and minds to those who need our help, in terms they can understand. In that way, we not only help them, but increase our own skills. No one can teach without learning from each individual he teaches. It is like bread cast upon the waters, coming back to us multiplied many times over - sometimes as family records we never hoped to find because someone we helped met a distant relative of ours and told him about our research - Sometimes when the pupil becomes the teacher of new sources of information or new techniques of research.
