NOTES: Seven graves are marked by small flowerpots - no headstones.  
Descendants of this family inform me Robert and Jane Anderson (Field)  
Hightower are buried in the same grave under the old cedar tree. They  
both died after 1842 and before 1850. Jane died first and Robert had her  
body preserved in alcohol and kept in a small building behind his house.  
He died a year or so later and the two were buried in the same grave.  
Two of Richard Lee Hightower's three wives are buried here, some small  
children, probably more of the Fields, also Richard Lee's sister Sarah  
and brother James, both of whom died unmarried and young.

Located on Giomer Farm on oiled road in south east part of Harrison Co. This cemetery has not been cared for many years. Part of it was destroyed when a stock pond was built. The names below were the only ones we could find. Hugh Strickland and members of his family are buried here, the markers have long since disappeared. This was a fairly large cemetery about one acre in size. Not a single stone standing.

## LOUISIANA OBITUARIES

These obituaries were taken from Tennessee newspapers, which will be identified at the end of each entry. Only the more sensational deaths from other states were reported in the papers.

KNIGHT, Mrs., the estimable wife of Mr. Knight of Pothoff & Knight, merchants in New Orleans, was killed by cars at New Orleans on Monday. (Memphis Daily Appeal, Thurs., 30 July 1868)

BACININI, (no first name, Italian, shot himself by the grave of his wife in Greenwood Cemetery in New Orleans...grief at her loss. (Memphis Daily Appeal, 21 Sept. 1868)

POPE, Colonel, late sheriff of St Mary's Parish, body sent north on the 21st accompanied by large number of U. S. soldiers including Gen. Rousseau and Gen. Buchanan; formerly colonel of the 33d Illinois. (Memphis Daily Appeal 22 Oct 1868)

McMURDO, John R., of New Orleans, age 54, died last Sunday; long eminent as a financier and political leader. (Memphis daily Appeal, 3 Dec 1868)

ROUSSEAU, Maj. Gen. Linell H., died at 11 p.m. on Jan. 7 and buried at New Orleans on the 10th. (Memphis Daily Appeal 9 May 1869)  
Gen Lovell Harrison Rousseau, born Lincoln Co., Ky., 1820; his father was first cousin of President Harrison; captain of Indiana volunteers in 1846 in Mexican War; served 1860 in Kentucky senate; served at Battle of Shiloh as division commander under Buell; buried at New Orleans; funeral at Carist Church under direction of Bishop of Louisiana; his pallbearers: Generals Hatch, Mower, Bickwith, Babcock, Porter, Tompkins, McClem, Sttedman, Herron, Lee, McMillan, Bussey, and Gurnery. (Memphis Daily Appeal 10 Jan 1869.)

LIDDELL, General St. John, of Catahoula Parish, was killed on the steamer St. Mary near New Orleans on Feb 14. (Memphis Daily Appeal 16 Feb 1870)

LANDING, Capt. Joseph Narcisse, has died; born in La. on 7 Sept. 1786, served in War of 1814 -15, commanding 6th regiment of Louisiana Volunteers; became quite wealthy. (Memphis Daily Appeal 4 April 1870)

JAMES, William C., of Alexandria, La., died on the 24th ult. from pistol ball wound received 10 days earlier when a navy revolver on the person of one of his sons accidentally discharged. (Memphis Daily Appeal 13 April 1870 )

FITZGERALD, Jim, well known sporting man, died in New Orleans on the 2nd. (Memphis Daily Appeal 4 May 1869)

RICHARDSON, John P., of east Carroll Parish, La., largest cotton planter in the world, died on Epps plantation Dec. 14; owned

15 plantation in Miss. and La., and 8 mercantile establishments.  
(Florence, Ala., Times, 26 Dec 1891)

BUNCH, Capt. Eugene, noted train robber, shot and killed posse while  
resisting arrest last week at Amite City, La. His partner  
Hopgood was captured. (Florence, Ala., Times 10 Sept. 1892 )

SIMONEAUX, Mr. of Centerville, near Franklin, La., was shot through  
head and died by one Gordy on 27 Jan. (Maury democrat, Cloumbia  
TN, 3 Feb 1887 )

JONES, Mrs. Nancy, age 106, died recently at Galveston, Texas...she  
remembered Revolutionary War times when her father took his flint  
lock from the walls of the old cabin and went away to battle.  
(Maury democrat 13 Sept. 1888)

ARNOLD, Dr. J. W. was shot and killed in August at Pandora Store,  
La., six miles above Shreveport, Bossier Parish, by W. J. McMath.  
(Maury Democrat 6 Sept 1888)

NEW ROADS, La. Pointe Coupe Parish neighborhood, Van Matthews and  
J. B. Woodruff had fight Nov. 15 over a land purchase. Matthews  
was killed and Woodruff is dying. (Maury Democrat 22 Nov. 1888)

RED BAYOU, LA., DeSoto Parish...during storm a red oak tree blew  
over on house of Joe Raffelo, killing or wounding six people.  
Mrs. Faffela, daughter Octana, 17, son Felix, 11, son Evan, 4,  
and William, 15 months, were all crushed to death. (Maury  
Democrat 26 June 1889)

CORMIER, --Regulators killed old man Rosemund Cornier and his  
daughter Rosalie, age 15, on Abbeville Road out from Lafayette,  
La. Their mutilated bodies found and they were murdered by a  
band of regulators who appeared 2 months ago...they whipped him at  
time and ordered him to leave. (Maury democrat \_\_ Sept. 1889.  
Date of paper illegible.)

BATALLE, Theodore Clement, age 96, native of France, died in  
Opelousas Parish, La...was in Battle of Waterloo. (Maury  
Democrat 17 Oct. 1889)

AIRY, Patrick, local prize fighter, was shot and killed on Nov. 11  
by Andy Berrill at New Orleans. (Maury democrat 14 Nov. 1889)

WHITE, Col. rador, 76, died at his residence a short distance from  
Shreveport, La., a few days ago; one of best known and most  
successful planters in the South, owned and controlled large  
plantations, but was a loser by the war; notwithstanding he h  
leaves his children in comfortable circumstances. Wife died a year  
ago... (Houston Co., TN, News 7 Aug. 1886)

LOUISIANA OBITUARIES CONT'D, by MRS. J. K. GARRETT

BOULANGER, Mrs., wealthy old French resident of Donaldsonville, La., was murdered by unknown tramp on the 2d, who struck her on head with a blunt instrument...robbery was the cause...he has not been arrested yet. (Houston county News, 8 Jan 1887)

LEROY, Most Reverend F. X., Archbishop of Louisiana, died in France; went there on the order of the Pope, wall ill when he left and did not expect to return; age 62; became Archbishop in 1881. (Houston County News, 7 Oct 1887)

BLANCHARD, General Albert G., 81, died sunday in New Orleans; graduated 1829 from West Point with Robert E. Lee and Albert S. Johnston. (Florence Ala. Times 4 July 1891 )

## MINUTES OF AMIABLE CHURCH RAPIDES PARISH LOUISIANA

THE Amiable Baptist Church, located in the Spring Creek Community, six miles northwest of Glenmora, in Rapides Parish, Louisiana, is said to have been the third oldest church west of the Mississippi River. It was constituted by Elder Joseph Willis on 6 September 1828, and held its first meeting at the home of Eli Batson.

Almost all of the records have been preserved, and inasmuch as Rapides Parish courthouse burned 1864 will serve as a very important tool for locating ancestors in this area. It is deplorable that the enumerator of the 1870 Federal Census failed to list the people living in a wide strip of land which was in that parish, but which was to be cut off and included in the new parish of Vernon created 1871. Many of those people belonged to this Baptist Church.

We are grateful to Mrs. Trenkins McClain who obtained a xeroded copy of the minutes through 1900, and they will be published in the "Genie" in subsequent issues.

NATCHITOCHE PARISH NOTES by FERN AINSWORTH

The following is a history of the barnhill family who lived in Natchitoches Parish, La. See page of 163 of the July 1978 Genie. Residence # 496 C. L. CRUMP listing. George Barnhill is a descendent of this listing branch.

This family whose surname was originally written DeBarneval (becoming Barneval, Berneval, Barnewall, Barnewell, Barnehell, Barnehill, Barnihill, Barnhill and probably Bramhall) is the parent stock from which the ancient and noble houses of Trimblestown and Kingslad branched. As the original spelling implies, the name is of French extraction and the family was allied to the Dukes of Little-Bretagne, where the name still continues in great repute. It was first established in Ireland in 1172 by Sir Michael DeBerneval, one of the companions in arms of "Strongbow", Earl of Pembroke.

Sir Michael DeVerneval, or Berneval, the first settler of the family in Ireland, landed at Leinster in 1172. He is mentioned in the records of the Tower of London, as one of the Chief Captains of the expedition in 1172. He was succeeded by his son.

Alanus De Barneval, who received two marks as the Kings gift for his expenses in going into Ireland, August 23 rd, 1212 AD. The King's mandate sent to Geoffrey De marisco directed that Hugh De Berneval should have seisin of his land at Drumenagh and Terrenure in the vale of Dublin, December 12, 1216. He died, unmarried, sine procure, without issue and a mandate for seisin of his lands was granted to his brother and heir.

Reginald DeBerneval, who was restored to lands in Drumenagh and Terrenure, January 24, 1228, 1229. He had a grant November 27, 1233 of 20 # Sterling a year, for his maintenance in the King's service (see mandate dated Sept. 28, 1234.) He was succeeded by his son.

Ulphram of Wolfram De Berneval, or Drumenagh, who was constable of Dublin Castle in 1278, 1279, and 1281, and Sheriff of the vale of Dublin in 1284 and 1289. He was a witness in 1289 to a deed between Hugh de Tyrell and the Prior and Convent of All Saints, near Dublin. He married Mary, the only daughter and heiress of Sir William Molyeux, Knight of Moylagh, County of Meathe, and was succeeded by his son.

Reginald Deverneval, (note the change in spelling) of Drumenagh, who paid five shillings for Drumenaghy as subsidy to the King for the war against the Scots in 1299. He married a daughter of Sir Conway Clifford, Knight, and was succeeded by his son.

Reginald Deverneval, (Jr.) of Drumenagh. In 1309 he gave thirty shillings for the Army of Loxendy, and in 1313 he paid his services for the expedition to Castle Kryrening, under Piers Gaveston. He died 1331, seised of a watermill, a dove-cote and profits of the Courts of Drumenagh and Terrenure, County Dublin, and was succeeded by his son.

Reginald DeBerneval, (the third) of Drumenagh, who contributed toward the expedition to Mollow, under Walter De Berminghame, in 1347, and in 1374 paid Royal Services for the Expedition to Kilkenny, under William de Windsor. He married Janetta, only daughter of Cusac of Killdeen, and left two sons:

(a) Wolfram or (Ulphram) who succeeded to Drumenagh. He was living, seised of the Manor of ballythermot, in 1400. His many descendants continued to reside at Drumenagh till the reign of Jas. I, when his line terminated in an heiress, Elizabeth, daughter of Marcus barnewall (note that in less than two generations the name has changed three different times) of Drumenagh, who married a cousin, James Barewall, of Bremare, and sold the property, Feb. 1st, 1607 to Sir Adam Loftus, Knight of RATHERA Farmham.

(b) Nicholas, ancestor of the baronets of Crickstown. His second son, Nicholas DeBerneval, of Crickstown, married a daughter of one Sir Clifford and had a son.

Sir Christopher De Berneval, of Crickstown, (the custody of 48 Shillings rent issuing out of Lucy-Aniston, County Meathe, held by Nicholas de Berneval, deceased of Roger, Earl of Ulster, the King's ward and in the King's hands by the minority of Christopher de Berneval, his son and heir, was granted to Richard Plunkett in April 1386); and married Eleanore, daughter of Sir Nicholas rochford, Knight of Rath, Coffee County, Kildare and Kilbride, County Meathe, and by her had:

1. Christopher, his successor
2. John of Frandstown, Sheriff of Meather, 1435, 1436, ancestor of the Viscounts Kingslands, (see Burke's Extince and Dormant Peerage).
3. Barnaby, one of the Barons of the Exchequer. He died before 1384 and was succeeded by his eldest son.

Sir Christopher Barnewall (here is less than a generation the names have been changed twice), Knight of Crickstown, a minor at his father's death. Sir Christopher became Sergeant-at-Law in 1408, Lord Treasurer of Ireland in 1436, and Chief Drake, marrying the daughter and heiress of the last Lord of Krykestown and Drakesrath, and left two sons:

1. Nicholas, his successor, and
2. Robert, high Lord Chancellor of Ireland, created March 4th, 1461, the Baron of Trimblestown. (See that title)

Sir Christopher was succeeded by his elder son,

Sir Nicholas Barnewall, (known in many passages in the records of the King's Bench, as Barnehell) Knight of the law, was appointed, in consideration of his good and faithful services to the House of York, during the War of Roses, Chief Justice of the Court of

Common Pleas, in Ireland for life, by patent dated August 1st, 1461. He married Ismay, daughter of and heiress of Sir Robert Serjeant, Knight of Castleknock, County Dublin, and had two sons,

1. Christopher, his successor and
2. Edmund, ancestor of the Barnewalls of Dunbrown.

We are left to speculate as to exactly what took place. We know that trouble of some nature developed between the Crown and the family of Sir Christopher Barnewall, but the exact nature has never been revealed. Sir Christopher and his family, evidently were disciplined by the King for some transgression. That Sir Christopher accepted the discipline and bowed in submission is indicated by the events which followed, namely that Sir Patrick, eldest son of Sir Christopher was knighted, and he (Sir Patrick) and his descendants continued in the Royal Service. We know, however, that the names shown above in capital letters followed by a \* did not bow in submission to the King's will and differed with their father Sir Christopher, upon the advisability of accepting the discipline meted out to the family. The second, the third and the fifth sons, Robert, John and James, were disowned and disinherited by their father, Sir Christopher and were branded as outlaws, were exiled to Scotland where they took the surname Barnehell (Becoming Barnehill,, Barnihill, Barnhill.) This happened about 1540 (actual date not established.) Sir Walter Scott in his "Lay of the Last Minstrel" refers to the "outlaw" Barnhill, as follows:

"On Minto crags the moon beams glint,  
Where Barhill hewed his bed of flint,  
Who flung his outlawed limbs to rest  
Where falcons hang their giddy nest."

An explanatory note to this verse says this Barnhills (plural) was a robber or outlaw. We also find in the same explanatory note that the towers of the Easter (n) (Probably originally reading "eastern" Barnhills) were thrown down. ( In English History we find the names of several men listed as outlaws who are listed in American History as "Patriots". These three brothers, Robert, John and James Barnehell, apparently were the first crusaders in the family for the cause of justice and give their all for what they honestly believed to be just, right and true.

Prior to this division of the House of Barnewall, the Barnewall family had all embraced the Catholic religion. Robert, John and James denounced the Catholic faith as well as the Royal House of Stuart and embraced Presbyterianism which had then only begun to spread over the country. Later when the British Crown embraced Episcopalianism and attempted to force British subjects to accept the choice of the Crown, the Barnhills became active crusaders for Presbyterianism as opposed to Episcopalianism. They also supported William of Orange in his crusade in opposition to move the to join the British and Scottish Crowns and first returned it to Ireland with William of Orange and participated in the Battle of the Boyne.

## FERN AINSWORTH'S NATCHITOCHEES PARISH NOTES CONT'D:

Descendants of Robert, John and James Barnehell are thought to have settled at what is now Barnhill, near Elgin, Scotland (research to establish this fact is now being carried on). Others moved to England and established the name Barnhill there.

Those Barnhills who returned to Ireland under William of Orange settled in Counties Tyrone and Antrim, Ireland, and became fiery Orangemen. So bitter was their attacks on the British Crown that they were hunted and persecuted for years by agents of the British Governments.

In 1689 there lived in Dublin, a young man by the name of John Barnhill, of Marnihill, who although a critic of the Government then in power, was not quite so outspoken as some other members of his family, and therefore had been permitted to live in comparative peace. He married Elizabeth (surname unknown). A few years after his marriage John Barnhill made a trip to London where he purchased type and other printing equipment and returned to Dublin where he built himself a printing press, making it out of Irish Oak. He and his wife, Elizabeth, who came from a family of high station and who was exceptionally well educated for one of that time, printed circulars and articles attacking the Royal House of Stuart, the proposal to join the Scotch and British Crowns and Episcopalianism as opposed to Presbyterianism, calling it English domination and religious intolerance. The Union Party of Britain, then in power, soon learned who printed these articles and set out to arrest John Barnhill. John, forewarned by friends and supporters, of this move after prearrangement with his wife, Elizabeth, he hid himself in the hold of a ship bound for the American Colonies. The British authorities could not find John Barnhill but they could and did confiscate his property. Elizabeth and their sons, either three or four sons at that time (later Elizabeth arrived in America accompanied by their four sons - it is possible that the fourth son was not yet born at the time of their persecution) fled to Scotland to take refuge from persecutuon, but first effectually hid the printing press so successfully that the Agents of the British Government never found it.

John Barnhill arrived in Baltimore in 1691. He immediately went to work and after several years accumulated enough money to bring his wife and family to the New World. They joined him here in possibly late 1690 but more probably early 1700. Elizabeth and their four sons bringing the printing press with them which they later set up in Baltimore where they printed articles telling of their persecution in Ireland which they sent back to Ireland for distribution.

John Barnhill kept a record of his family which he handed down to one of his sons who added to it and passed it to his son. This grandson of John barnhill, while visiting at home of a cousin in Pittsburgh in 1865 took sick and died of Cholera and the records passed into the possession of this cousin, who, after the death of his first wife had married again. His secound wife, one day in a rage and in an attempt to spite her step-sons, burned the records

and accompanying papers. Thus perished the Barnhill records and the writing of our great-grandparents.

Prior to this catastrophe, Judge J. H. Barnhill of New Philadelphia, Ohio was visiting the home of this Barnhill in Pittsburgh and saw and read these records. He described the writing of Elizabeth particularly as literary wonders, which showed exceptionally well, her wonderful education and refinement. When he learned of the destruction of the Barnhill records, the Judge reconstructed them as well as he could from memory, thus we have a skeleton form of the records today, though perhaps not entirely correct in all details.

Robert Barnhill, second Barnhill immigrant to the American Colonies, came from the northern part of Ireland and arrived in Philadelphia, Sept. 28, 1734 (so says Mrs. Emma Dunn Mastin of Owensboro, Ky.). They settled in New Britain Township, Bucks County, Pennsylvania. Family record follows: In this record is shown only the descendants of William Barnhill who was the son of the immigrant Robert Barnhill above referred to as to show all the descendants of Robert Barnhill would require too much space.)

WILLIAM BARNHILL referred to as (d) above, b in Bucks County, Pa., 1735 d in S.C. 1810 m Isabell Barr. He purchased 135 acres of Joseph Arthur in New Britain June 30, 1761 and another tract of 150 acres in same township of Thomas Evans Mar. 20 1762. On June 5, 1767, while proprietor of the Tavern at Warwick Crossroads, now Hartsville, he and his wife Isabelle or (Isabel) conveyed the latter tracts to John Wisler for 750L. This tract adjoined the farm of his brother Samuel Barnhill, in the records of Deep Run Presbyterian Church, Bedminster Township, Buck County, Pa., founded 1732 there is a subscription list for the building of a house for Rev. James Latta, the paston, in Feb 1761. Among the subscribers were Samuel Barnhill who gave three shillings and William Barnhill, Sr., who gave one shilling. On Oct. 18th, 1767 (so states Mrs. Emma Dunn Mastin of Owensboro Ky.) William Barnhill and family, in company with Henry Finley and archibald Finley, Jr. moved to N.C., the Finley brothers stoppin in London County, Va., and William Barnhill and family continuing southward to N.C., finally settling in Craven County and later moving to York Co. S.C.

WILLIAM BARNHILL, SR. served in the Revolutionary War in the North Carolina Militia as a Private; and acted as assessor in Mecklenburg County, N.C. in 1788 when the county was divided into military districts. (Ref. American Monthly Magazine, Jul 1907, p 8).

In 1797 William Barnhill bought 231 acres of land "on the waters of Allison Creek" from Walter McCarter. On Feb 20, 1798, William Barnhill, Sr. sold to Samuel Barnwell 200 acres in York County, S.C. on the south branch of Allison Creek for 400 £. There seems to be no more available records of his land conveyances. The last date found with reference to William Barnhill is May, 4, 1810 when he died at the age of 75 years. He is buried in the Bersheeba Church yard in York County, near the town of York, S.C., and the gravestone (with the inscriptions of his and his wife and daughter, Isabelle, Jr is still well preserved with the lettering very distinct.

The children of William Barnhill and Isabelle Barr were:

- (8) Sarah, who married Francis Armstrong.

Concerning the Revolutionary service of William Barnhill, Sr., He is listed as paid for services in the Adjutant General's office at Raleigh, N. C. (Book 6, page \$, Indes Vol. I)

William Barnhill, Jr., referred to as (5) above was born in South Carolina in 1776. In 1796 he married Cynthia Hodge, daughter of John Hodge and Mary Elliott. In the migration westward of this family, we find on Mar. 25, 1814 a land transfer of 287½ acres for the sum of \$225, from James Adams and Dorcas, his wife, of Elbert County, Ga., to William Barnwell and "Sentha" (Cynthia) of Franklin Co., Ga., on the north Fork of the Broad River by William Elliott's land.

On Nov.2, 1818, William Barnwell and "Sentha" (Cynthia) of Franklin Co.,Ga., sold the above 287½ acres for \$1,000 to William Bice of the same county. Wittnesses to the deed were Elizabeth Armstrong (probably a niece of William Barnhill) and William Hodge Barnhill, a son of William and Cynthia. During the family's wanderings they came to live a short time in Barnesville, Lamar Co., Ga., where many years later the signature of William Barnhill was found on the ancient register of an old log inn at which the family stopped on their arrival in the village. They moved westward through Alabama to Tennessee and in 1826 settled on Muddy Creek where they were living on Feb 23, 1831, when

William Barnhill of McNairy County, Tenn. appointed his brother, John Barnhill of the District of York, and State of South Carolina, his true and lawful Attorney in Fact, to sell his share of the land of the estate of his father William Barnhill. In October of 1835 we find the older members of the family, at least William and Cynthia, the parents, in the State of Texas, at which time William applied for "one league and a Labour of Land" in Nacadoches, Texas. This application was filed for record Oct. 5, 1839. The land was later divided into smaller counties and the above tract is now in Wood County.

William Barnhill, Jr. died in Nacadoches, Texas near Brenham, in 1838, and the family moved back to Tennessee the following year where the widow Cynthia Hodge Barnhill died in 1848. (Another record says that they both (William and Cynthia) returned to Tennessee before William's death in 1838 and that both of them died in Tennessee.

Detailed founding and financing of the many Christian works are found in this great history.
