The Auditor of the State of Ohio will search their index of land patents for free with a SASE (required). Send your ancestor's name, possible location and date to: Auditor of the State of Ohio, P.O. Box 1140, Columbus, OH 43216.

Once you have received the information from the State of Ohio confirming that your ancestor did receive an original land patent, send all the information you received from the state of Ohio, along with \$4.25 to the Bureau of Land Management, Eastern States Office, 350 S. Pickett St., Alexandria, VA 22304.

After you receive a copy of the original land patent, sometimes additional information may be obtained from the land entry files by writing to: General Branch (NNFG), Civil Archives Division, National Archives & Records Service (GSA), Washington, DC 20409

Also included are "miscellaneous remarks" and brief information about place of birth, age, occupation, residence, marital status, and other personal statistics.

A Letter Back Home

Phillipsburg, 18 Jan 1833

Dear Friend and Brother in Christ

Before my departure from Frankfurt, I wrote to you under 7 July 1831 once more and gave you the news that Herr PROLI, our spiritual leader, and several families had left and that I would follow after him, as I actually still did on that day.

We all arrived safely here in America, and I was ever concerned, as soon as circumstances would permit, to write to you, but this was not practicable, since we had no firm place of residence.

But now I am happy to be able to write you that on 21 march the New-Philadelphian Community was founded, the renewed Christian Church, with community of property, as in the days of the apostles, who had everything in common.

The Count de LEON (this name is assumed by our spiritual leader) has purchased the town of Phillipsburg, 27 English miles, or 9 hours below Pittsburgh, and our community now numbers 400 souls.

If you therefore would wish to join the New Philadelphian community in belief and trust in the glorious coming of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, in order to prepare for the Kingdom of God-for without preparation and gathering of the faithful the new foundation can not be made, and believers would go to ruin with the unbelievers if no gathering place were established by God, where the better people should be preserved until the Judgement (punishments) of God over Europe should be over, and all godlessness is extirpated. This revelation is found in the 4th Book of Ezra, under the name of Ansoreth (?) that is, the world realm. If you therefore still have a mind to follow the voice of God, then do not lose a moment, but sell all you may have and openly emigrate, as so many Germans have done in previous years and will do in this year.

The journey by way of Bremon is best. The cost is 80 f, including board, and we leave by ship to Baltimore. When you get to Baltimore you will find Germans enough who will arrange for you to get to Pittsburgh. And from Pittsburgh it is 9 hours to Phillipsburg, and from there you can come to us within another 3 hours.

By fall we expect to move farther West, and I hope that by that time you will be with us. We have built a small church. We have singing and preaching. Our spiritual leader teaches us out of Holy Writ. The holy offering is not yet instituted, but will be when circumstances permit. the holy priesthood will then be installed and divine service will be held as holily and festively as never before on earth.

We have people from all origins, who now and again are instructed, and our community grows day by day.

Whatever money anyone had had been deposited to the communal account, for which a certificate is given, so that if anyone is not satisfied, he may have his money back and go elsewhere-Everything any one may need is given gratis, and the people are very well off.

Letter continued:

Whoever is not a good Christian, nor wished to be can not be received as a member. The people must join purely out of submission to the will of God.

Provide yourselves well with clothes and linens and beds, for such things are here expensive.

The Father JOHANNES will still have to wait for a time, until the Dear God comes to save him.

At home in Walduren (?) I have two brothers-in-law. The one is a wagon-maker named George LEIBOLD. The other is named Joseph SCHIFFERDECKER. They will also come to us in America. You can talk things over with them.

If you decide to come, then write me a few lines, and when you get to Baltimere, then write me a few more lines, so that I can provide for you.

The grace of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ be with you all. Rejoice and be glad in the Lord our God, for the time of salvation is near.

Make haste so you may come to freedom, for the day of reckoning draws ever nearer, and finally no one may escape. How terrible it will be for those who remain without.

The fulfillment of all prophecies of God has taken a long time, and the world shall finally come to know when all things shall be fulfilled. Amen, Amen.

Greet all our brothers and sisters in Christ and write me soon in reply.

Fare you right well and be assured that I shall deal altogether uprightly with you. Your brother and \_\_\_\_\_,
