At a meeting of the stockholders of the Little Rock and Fort Smith Railroad Company on December 22, 1869, the directors elected were C. G. Scott, U. M. Rose, Edw. Wheeler, James A. Martin, J. H. Haney and James Lawson of Pulaski county; Anderson Gordon of Conway county, J. L. Shinn of Pope County and A. J. Ward of Crawford county.

In the early part of 1881, G. H. Van Etten, president of the Little Rock Furniture Factory, commenced building a new and larger plant west of the Iron Mountain depot on Lincoln Avenue.

THE FIELD-FIELD FAMILY IN ARKANSAS

On September 13, 1831, (one hundred years ago) the Arkansas Gazette published the following:

"The venerable subject of this obituary was the father of our respected fellow-townsman, William Field, clerk of the Superior Court of this Territory. We copy it from the Louisville Public Advertiser of the 20th ult.: "Died at his residence in the county, Major Abner Field, aged 71 years. In announcing the death of one of our oldest citizens, we do not aim at a labored panegyric; we would cheerfully award to his memory a better tribute. He served his country four years in the War of the Revolution, and suffered all the hardships and dangers of that long period as a volunteer; he fought at the siege of Yorktown, when Lord Cornwallis surrendered to the victorious army of George Washington. Soon after that memorable epoch, which terminated the arduous struggle of our veteran forefathers for liberty and independence, he emigrated to this section of Kentucky, from Culpepper, Va., where he was born. This county was then a perfect wilderness, resounding with the yell of savages and beasts of prey. On the same spot, now covered by a commercial city, blessed with the arts and refinements of civilized life, he contested the ground against the tomahawk and scalping knife of the aborigines. The deceased was one of the early adventurers to Kentucky, and at the time he landed at Louisville, the population of the whole state did not exceed 500; but he lived to see that number augment to 600,000, and a city of 1,200 on the ground then occupied by an imperious canebrake. Major Field was the first delegate who represented this county in the Virginia Legislature, and perhaps the first who represented it in the Legislature of this state—but now he sleeps in the ground for which he often risked his lift. After suffering a painful and protracted affliction he died in peace."

William Field was the father of Ben Johnson Field Sr. He was the father of Ben J. Field, who married Miss Mary Weaver. She now lives in Little Rock, in the Field home at Sixth and Cumberland Streets, where she was born. One of the daughters of William Field, Jane Elizabeth,

married Gov. Henry M. Rector. Another daughter, Ann, married Maj. William Rapley and another daughter, Ellen, married Col. Ben T. DuVal. Another son of Maj. Abner Field was Judge John Pope Field, who went to Washington, Ark., shortly after reaching Little Rock. Judge John Pope Field married Mary Jane Trimble of Virginia, and was the father of Mollie Field, who married Capt. Thomas Simms. Mrs. Simms is now living in Albuquerque, N.M. with her sons, John and Albert Simms. Mrs. Elbert Brack of Little Rock is a daughter of Capt. Thomas Simms. Another daughter of Judge John P. Field, was Fanny Field, who married Rev. John P. Lowry, now living in Little Rock. William Field was the first judge of the Municipal Court of Little Rock, and was postmaster of Little Rock in the early days. He and his brother, Judge John Pope Field were nephews of Gov. John Pope and came to Arkansas with him. Their mother was Jane Pope, sister of Governor Pope of Arkansas and Hon. Nathaniel Pope who was secretary of Illinois Territory in 1809, and delegate to the 14th Congress in 1816 and was appointed United States district judge. At the time of his death, his nephew, Col. Alexander Pope Field, was secretary of state of Illinois.

Judge William Field and Judge John Pope Field were eighth cousins of James Feild of Virginia, who married Henrietta Maria Anderson, parents of Judge William Hume Feild, who married Mary Amanda Flournoy at Locust Hill, Tenn. Judge William Hume Feild came to Arkansas in 1843, and was judge of the Fifth Judicial Circuit for many years. Judge William Hume Feild was the father of the late William Hume Feild of Little Rock, grandfather of the late William Pressley Feild, Ernest J. Feild and Joseph H. Feild. William Pressley Feild Jr., present deputy of the United States District Court, is a great-great grandson of Judge William H. Feild.

Judge William H. Feild was also the father of Silas Flounoy Feild, Mary D. Crockett, O.B. Feild and William Allen Feild of Little Rock, and Miss Nan Feild, Mrs. H. L. Parkinson and Mrs. Ralph Gilchrist of Washington, D. C. are the only living children of Silas F. Feild. William Terry Feild of Little Rock and Talbot Feild of Hope, Ark., are grandsons of Silas Flounoy Feild. Frank A. Feild of Washington, D. C. is another

Another son of Judge William Hume Feild, was the late Dr. Julian C. Feild of Dennison, Tex., whose son, Julian Feild, is now living there with his family. Mrs. Gilbert Knapp, deceased, of Little Rock, was a daughter of Judge William Hume Feild. Judge Feild died in 1861 and is buried in Mount Holly cemetery, by his wife.

LITTLE ROCK DIRECTORY 60 YEARS AGO

Probably the most popular book in Little Rock 60 years ago was a little volume of 124 pages, the reading matter of which consisted almost exclusively of names. It was the Little Rock Directory, the first ever published in the capital city of Arkansas.

A copy of this first city directory, published in 1871 by Henderson & Albertson, is owned by D. L. Phillips, land commissioner of the Missouri Pacific Railroad.

The volume lists approximately 2,000 names, giving the occupation and address of each person. The alphabetical arrangement is carried only to the first two letters of each name; thus we find several Hunters listed, then Huyck, Hussey, Hughen, and some more Hunters. But that was all right in those days; there weren't enough names in any letter group to make it difficult to find one particular name.

In addition to the directory of residents, there is a map of the city of Little Rock showing, among other things, "East Main street" and "West Main street." The former is now Main street and the latter Broadway.

There also is a list of state and federal officers: O. A. Hadley was governor then; H. C. Caldwell, federal judge, and James L. Hodges was postmaster,

Jeff G. Botsford heads the list of city officers as mayor; M. L. Andrews was police judge, and Frank R. Vance was chief of police. There

were only eight aldermen: Fred Kramer and Charles Tipton, First ward; Calvin Sanders and D. P. Upham, Second ward; Asa L. Richmond and David H. Robinson, Third ward, and Daniel Ottenheimer and James V. Fitch, fourth ward.

N. P. Gates was superintendent of public schools. There were three schools for white children-Sherman, Peabody and Kramer-and four for negroes-Union, Howard, Battery and Capitol Hill.

The chief engineer of the Little Rock Fire Department was Henry Page, who was assisted by M. H. Rottaken, T. C. Scott, Myer Pollock, W. D. Blucher and G. S. Brack. Four volunteer fire companies are listed: The Pat Cleburne, Defiance, Torrent No. 4, and Pulaski No. 2. Each had a foreman, an assistant foreman, a foreman of hose, an assistant foreman of hose, a treasurer, and a secretary.

Only two benevolent associations are listed, the Masonic and Odd Fellows. There were 10 churches for whites and four for negroes.

Two railroad time tables are included in the volume, one for the Little Rock and Fort Smith as far as Lewisburg, (near the present Morrilton) and the other for the Memphis and Little Rock as far as DeVaill's Bluff.

In addition to this information the first directory contains brief histories of the Arkansas Deaf Mute Institute, which had been in existence only three years, and the Arkansas Institute for the Education of the Blind, which, three years previously, had been removed to Little Rock from Arkadelphia, which was "not easily arrived at, except in one direction, say four months of the year, via the Ouachita river."

In their introduction, Henderson & Albertson say:

"In presenting the Little Rock Directory for 1871, the first ever issued, to the attention of the public, the publishers take occasion to say that no pains or expense has been spared to make it as correct as possible. The nature of such work makes perfection impossible.

"The numbers will be found to coincide with those put up by the city, with possibly some few exceptions.

"The publishers return thanks to the manufacturers, merchants and others, that have so generously bestowed their advertising patronage

upon them. The collection is a valuable one, and will be of interest to all citizens and strangers."

It is this general "advertising patronage" which proves most interesting to the average reader of the first city directory today. The advertisements clearly reflect the manners and customs of the times 60 years ago and offer interesting opportunities for comparison with modern times.

On the first advertising page, William S. Davis, proprietor of the Accommodation Hack Line, announced: "Through in One Day to Hot Springs." He was prepared with "very superior ambulances, good teams, and attentive drivers to transport invalids and others to the Hot Springs of Arkansas at figures as low as the lowest."

Another form of transportation which played an important part in the development of the state is exemplified in the advertisement of the Memphis and Arkansas River Packet Company, the United States Mail Line, which announced that "The Elegant Steamers of this Line leave Memphis for Little Rock on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays at 5 o'clock p. m. and Little Rock for Memphis on Mondays, Thursdays and Saturdays at 5 o'clock p.m."

The Torrent Cigar Emporium advertised: "Attention, Ye Lovers of the Weed and Fine Cigars! A Smoking Palace will be opened in Dr. Dodge's Row, Markham street, by John Reigler."

An unusual service if mentioned in the advertisement of the French Barber Shop, 113 East Markham street, which announced, among other things, "Dying Whiskers, 35 cents to \$1." Depending upon the yardage, no doubt,

And how long since you've eaten a whortleberry? Halsey & French had 'em in 1871, as well as gooseberries, blackberries, strawberries, raspberries, and every other fruit or berry you could mention.

Doctors and surgeons and dentists had no ethics in those days which prohibited advertising, and we find several dignified announcements by those professional men. Only in those days dentists were surgeon dentists and professors of operative dentistry.

LITTLE ROCK DIRECTORY (Cont'd)

Of course, in this Volsteadian era, it is entertaining to read the liquor advertisements of 60 years ago. Whether you sigh and shed a silent tear for the good old days, or rejoice that no such advertisements are possible now, the announcements are interesting.

For example, Tom's Saloon invited the readers of the first city directory to "Call When You Want to 'Smile'" and Burke's Saloon boasted of its hot apple toddy, Tom and Jerry, cognac brandy, hot Scotch Whiskey, punch, English India pale ale, hot rum punch, McGinniss' XX, Brown Porter, and hot Irish whiskey punch.

And for the quaffers of "suds" there was the Lager Beer Hall on Markham street opposite the Pacific hotel, which dealt in imported Rhine Wines and St. Louis lager beer and boasted of the only bowling alley in the city.

In the early months of 1870, Captain Adams, who already had built two boats at Little Rock, was at work on a steamboat for Colonel Nash of Fort Gibson, "in the Cherokee territory," to be used as a ferry boat. Native wood was used and, with the exception of the engine, which was supplied by a Cincinnati company, all material came from Little Rock and its vicinity.

EARLY SETTLERS IN "CEDED LANDS" OF GEORGIA

After the treaty with the Indians the area called "THE CEDED LANDS", was open for settlement. Land courts were established at Dartmouth, afterwards Petersburg, to issue grants for land for those desiring to settle in the new area. This land office was situated a short distance above the confluence of the Savannah and Broad Rivers. This is now Elbert County. There was a land office at Wrightsborough, now McDuffie County.

The following grants were made between 1773 and 1775 in the area which is now Lincoln County:

ABNEY, Nathan, a wife and two children; a boy aged 3, and a girl aged 4 months; and a negro. 100 acres on the Savannah River near Douglas Island.

ARMSTRONG, John, a wife, 2 sons and 2 daughters, ages 4 to 13. 150 acres at a spring running into Soap Creek at O'Neal's Path.

BARDEN, Randal, of South Carolina, a wife, a son and a daughter aged 7 to 17 years old. 250 acres on a branch of Piston Creek about 3 miles from Savannah River, in lieu of a place already entered.

DEAN, William of South Carolina, a wife and one son age 10 months. 100 acres on Savannah River whereon Neil lives, above lands petitioned for by Mr. Edward Keating.

DOOLY, John of South Carolina, a wife and 3 sons from the ages 1 to 4 years, and three orphan nephews from the age of 10 to 19 years. 250 acres on Savannah River at Lee's old place and 250 acres adjoining.

KEATING, Lieutenant Edward. 24 negroes; 300 acres on Savannah River below Fishing Creek adjoining Gustavous and William Duloney.

KEATING, Edward - 150 acres on Savannah River adjoining the previously granted 300 acres, and includes an island opposite the 300 acre tract.

KENNEDY, Henry, a wife, a son and 4 daughters. 50 acres at a place called High Hill Fork, a mile above the Upper Trading Path on Soap Creek.

LAMAR, Thomas, Jr. a wife and 1 son 4 years old. 100 acres on Fishing Creek where Semore cut a parcel of logs.

LOW, Ebenezer, himself only from No. Carolina ; 100 acres on Little River above Cherokee Ford.

MACLEMURRAY, James of South Carolina, himself only, 100 acres resigned by Patrick Maclemurray on Soap Creek.

MACLEMURRAY, Patrick, South Carolina, a wife, 1 son and 2 daughters. The son 5 years old, the daughters younger. 100 acres on Soap Creek joining 100 acres of the lower side reserved for Benjamin Mosley. Major Chievers, a free negro now lives on said creek.

MIDDLETON, Hugh, South Carolina, a wife, 4 sons and 2 daughters from 9 months to 11 years old, and 10 negroes. 300 acres at Pistol Creek adjoining the lower line and Savannah River, including land formerly surveyed for Gideon Chivers.

MILLS, Alexander, South Carolina, a wife, 5 sons and 2 daughters, aged 4 to 16 years old. 150 acres on Listol Creek 2 miles above the mouth the mouth on the upper side of the creek.

MOSLEY, Benjamin, North Carolina, a wife, 2 boys and 5 girls between 5 months and 15 years old. 100 acres on Soap Creek at Butchers Cabin.

PATTEN, Jacob, a wife 7 daughters and 6 negroes. 100 acres at Pistol Creek on the Trading Path 5 miles from the river.

PUGH, Jesse, North Carolina, a wife, 5 sons and 1 daughter aged 2 to 16 years. 100 acres on north side of Little River below Maclemurray's old place, including the spring.

SIMMONS, Stern, South Carolina, 100 acres on Soap Creek above the Cherokee Road on both sides of the middle fork where Casey lived.

TAYLOR, Ward, South Carolina, a wife, 3 sons and 2 daughters age 3 to 11 years. 150 acres on Soap Creek above the Lower Trading Path.

WATERS, Lieutenant Thomas, South Carolina, 11 negroes. 200 acres on Savannah River near Fishing Creek bounded on south by lands of Bryan Ward.

After Lincoln County was formed and INFERIOR COURT was established, which tried all cases not reserved to the SUPERIOR COURT, and exercised the same jurisdiction over county affairs that is now exercised by THE COURT OF ORDINARY. Its' jurisdiction was over estates, and other purely county matters. With the establishment of this court and the Superior Court, the county was organized into a local government.
