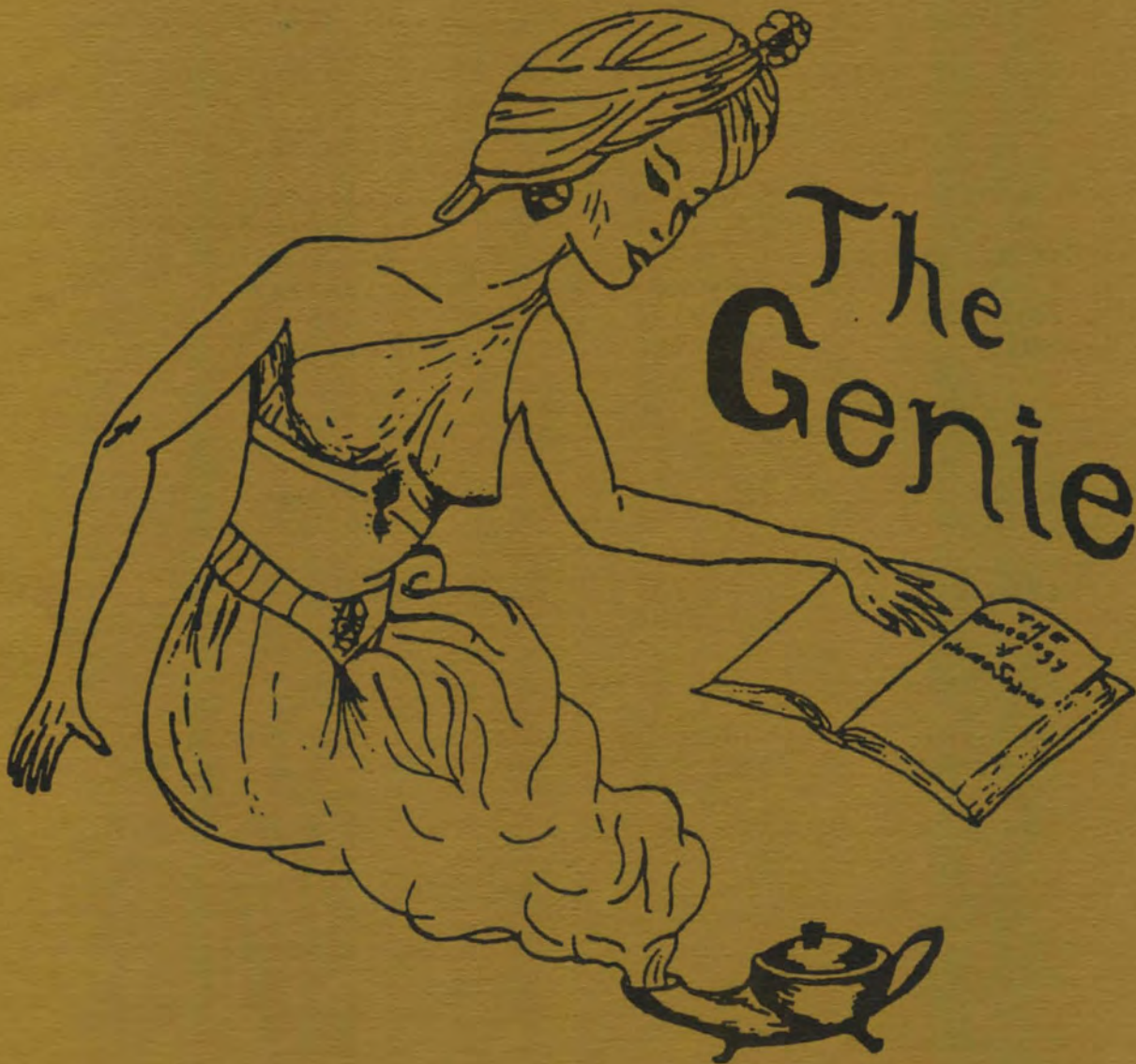

## "WHERE DO WE GO FROM HERE?"

So many times budding genealogists jump into their research with great enthusiasm, but without some preliminary preparation; and inevitably, they come up against a 'brick wall', and then wonder where to go next, or how to solve this research problem. May I suggest to you, new genealogists, three things you must do first before you hurry off to search for your 'roots'.

### STUDY HISTORY

The first thing you must do, and it is a 'must' before tackling any research problem, is to study all you can on the historical background of a particular state, county, or area where your people lived. Many factors in history shaped the lives of your ancestors - wars, epidemics, economic problems, persecutions, politics, droughts, unemployment, etc. All these and many more had profound impact on your ancestors. For example: Hundreds of Regulators (who had organized in 1764 to resist oppressive and corrupt public officials, but resorted to violence) and their families left Orange County, North Carolina within a short time, after their crushing defeat by the Royal Forces in 1771; and, moved to the Tennessee country. By knowing what was going on in their area, you will be able to know what events were shaping their lives, what caused them to move, or to settle where they did.

### HISTORIES OF CHURCHES

While you are studying histories of the actual locality, don't overlook the histories of churches and religious denominations. You will find that the various religious groups would migrate together. Many of these sects kept some kind of records - some records are better than others, however. There are depositories for many of these church records in various university libraries. A study of the religious background of your ancestors will give you an appreciation of their customs and their migration to and across this great nation.

### MAPS

The next thing you must do is to equip yourself with a map, as near the period of time your ancestors lived in that county, and study the physical description or surfact features of the state, county, or area where you are working. It is important to have some knowledge of the location of rivers, marshes, mountains, and other natural barriers; because, topography dictated the migration patterns of settlers into and out of an area. Your ancestors might have traveled into counties, or over the boundaries into other states before arriving at their destination. By knowing the migration routes, you will be able to find them in some of the records in the counties and states they passed through.

## BOUNDARY DISPUTES

There have been boundary disputes between states, such as, North Carolina and Virginia; Tennessee and North Carolina; South Carolina and North Carolina; and etc. Quite often the two disputing states would grant land to their citizens in the disputed area; and, when the boundary was finally settled, one group of land holders would find they were now in a different state and their title to the land would be threatened. Just such a thing happened to some North Carolina land owners, who found themselves in South Carolina's jurisdiction when the boundary between the two states was settled in 1768. South Carolina required that these North Carolinians surrender their old Letters of Patent from the Province of North Carolina; and, procure new grants from the Province of South Carolina. If they refused to do so South Carolina would deem the land vacant and would grant the same to others applying for that land. Such problems like this would generate some kind of record.

## COURT SYSTEMS

The third thing you must have, and the one most often ignored or avoided is a working knowledge of the court system of the state, and county. The reason researchers side step the courts and their records is because, generally speaking, their records were difficult to read, and to understand the legal terminology. The records, usually aren't indexed and almost never abstracted or published, thus making it difficult to find needed information on an ancestor. Nevertheless, a knowledge of the various court systems, idiosyncrasies, type of record kept, their contents, laws which governed the keeping of specific records, which courts kept probate records, which kept deeds and marriages, would aid you tremendously to find those records which will help you genealogically, and those which will not.

## LAY GROUNDWORK

The degree to which you lay some groundwork before proceeding to do actual research may well spell the difference between success in solving your research problems or failure and frustration. Remember it doesn't take much to be a poor genealogist, but it takes a little longer, some effort, study, lots of time, and determination to be a good one.

# THE FRENCH REPUBLICAN CALENDAR

Beginning 22 September 1792 those parts of Germany under French administration switched from the Gregorian to the French Republican calendar. This calendar was used for the next fourteen years until 1 January 1806 (11 Nivose XIV). Therefore, when researching records in certain parts of Germany for this period, you will find dates according to the French Republican calendar which you will want to convert to Gregorian calendar equivalents. To do this you need a conversion chart such as the one below.

Begin by converting the year (in French, An).

An I	1792/93	An VIII	1799/1800
An II	1793/94	An IX	1800/01
An III	1794/95	An X	1801/02
An IV	1795/96	An XI	1802/03
An V	1796/97	An XII	1803/04
An VI	1797/98	An XIII	1805/05
An VII	1798/99	An XIV	1805/06

The French Republican year fell into 12 months each of which had only 30 days. Therefore, if a date falls late in the month of Nivose, it will be necessary to add one year to it. For example, 14 Nivose An VI is converted by counting from 21 December 1797 to 3 January of the next year, 1798.

In the conversion chart below find the French Republican month and then move to the column of the particular French Republican year. The resultant date represents the first day of the French Republican month converted to its Gregorian Calendar equivalent.

Study the following computation for 14 Nivose An VI:

Step 1: French Republican Date 14 Nivose An VI  
Subtract 1                    - 1  
                                  13

Step 2: 1 Nivose is equal to 21 December 1797

Step 3: Add remainder in Step 1 to number of Gregorian day in Step 2:

$$13 + 21 = 34$$

Step 4: Subtract the number of days for December in the Gregorian calendar:

$$34 - 31 = 3$$

Step V Since we have gone 3 days beyond December, we are now into January of the next year. Therefore, the date is 3 January 1798.

Remember, always subtract 1 from the French Republican day. The remainder will always be added to the number for the Gregorian day in the appropriate column on the above conversion chart.

Here is the conversion we made:

French Republican date =	14 Nivose An VI
1 Nivose	= 21 December 1797
Counting the 21 as 1, add	$\frac{13}{34}$
Less days in December	- $\frac{31}{31}$
Gregorian date	= 3 January 1798

Translation of the names of the French Republican Calendar months (remember the year began 22 September): Vintage, Fog, Sleet, Snow, Rain, Wind, Seed, Blossom, Pasture, Harvest, Heat, Fruit. Napoleon abolished this calendar at the end of 1805.

N. O., 2 May A.D. 1842, an election was held at the Natchitoches precinct in the parish of Natchitoches in said State for the purpose of electing of representatives & other officers commencing on 4 day of July A. D. 1842 & ending 5 & 6 day of same month & year, at which election we proceeded to take the (sense) of the persons qualified to vote for representatives as to the necessity and expediency of calling a convention to amend the constitution at which election the following electors appeared & voted as follows, to wit:
