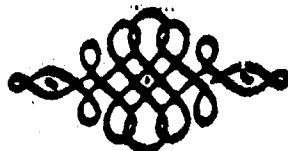

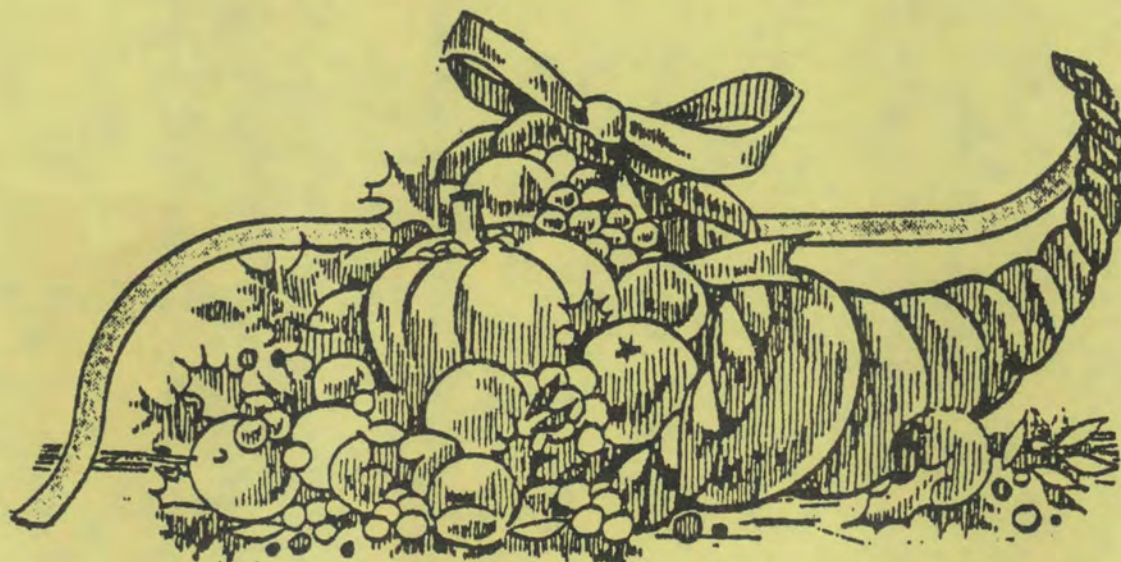

SEVEN HORSE POWER LINIMENT

Coal Oil, Camphor and Turpentine equal parts, to each pint add two ounces of Capsicum, two ounces Laudanum. For stock add one ounce Corrosive Sublimate. Will cure all bone diseased on horses or mules.

EYE WATER

Sugar of Lead, two parts, White Vitral, one part reduced with rainwater.

TEXAS CHILL TONIC

One gallon strong plumroot tea, add one quart Alcohol, one-half ounce Quinine. Shake well before taking.

POORMAN'S FIRE

Sulphuric Acid one bottle, Chlorate of Potash pulverized, and Turpentine is what burns.

DROPSY

Burnt Buckshorn pulverized, four tablespoonful, two of Saltpeter put in one quart of water. Dose: Four tablespoonful three times a day.

To make balky horses pull-tie a rock in each ear.

To keep horses from jumping fences-Tie a piece of iron to its foretop.

To keep sheep from jumping a fence-Tie a sharp stick to his tail.

Salve that cures all sores-Beeswax. mutton tallow and English rosin equal parts stewed together, when done add one ounce pulverized verdegres, this makes one pint.

"I'LL TAKE THIS 'UN," SAID HONEYCUTT AS HE CHOSE HIS WIFE

(Extracted from the Centennial Edition of THE GAZETTE, Farmerville, Union Parish LA, October 5, 1939, by Carroll H. Goyne, Jr.)

FIRST SETTLER CAME TO THIS SECTION IN 1790

In 1790, the first settler fought his way across the wilds of Alabama, Mississippi and northern Louisiana to reach what is now Union Parish. He was John Honeycutt.

He started the trail-blazing into this country that was to draw hundreds, then thousands, of settlers, into this virgin territory. From the sparsely settled Alabama, Georgia and the Carolinas came the adventurers. Soon there were homesites along the Bayous D'Arbonne, Cornie and DeLoutre, in the "Ouachita settlements" section, as the Union Parish territory was designated in 1807. In that year, the Territory of New Orleans was divided into 19 parishes.

To get back to Honeycutt, he settled in this land that was full of wild life and a veritable paradise for a trapper. He received a land grant from the Spanish government and began to eke out his living here with only Indians as his neighbors.

Then, one day a few years after he first entered this section, he met a roving band of Indians. They told him of another family that had settled in this territory. Putting his coonskin cap on his head, and with his flintlock in the crook of his arm, Honeycutt set out to follow the Indians' direction to their cabin.

He found an old settler with a "house full of girls." The story goes that he asked the old father for the hand of one. Obliging, the old man lined the daughters up for Honeycutt's inspection.

"I'll take this 'un," the trapper said. And he did.

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BOOK REVIEWS

The following books were donated to the Ark-La-Tex Genealogical Association by Virginia Lee McKay, and are not for sale. We wish to thank Virginia for her generous gift. The books will be presented to Shreve Memorial Library, Shreveport, LA.

TITLE: THE STEPHENS FAMILY AND TUCKER FAMILY RECORDS by Nell Stephens Murfree. 1964

This family record begins with David Dudley Stephens, born 15 May 1814 in Marlborough Co., SC. He married Nancy McKinnon and they had 8 children. The first 3 children were born in SC. The family then moved to AL stopping in Rockingham, NC for the birth of twins in 1848, before settling in Louisville, AL. This book follows the family of the first child, Nelson Kinnon Stephens, and his wife Mary Katherine Tucker and their 12 children, down to the present. There are many pages of early documentation and interesting notes of the author, many pictures and biographies. Size 9½ x 6½. Hard Bound. 317 Pages. It is a beautiful book but suffers from lack of an index.

TITLE: SOME TEMPLE PEDIGREES: A GENEALOGY OF THE KNOWN DESCENDANTS OF ABRAHAM TEMPLE WHO SETTLED IN SALEM, MASSACHUSETTS IN 1636. By Levi Daniel Temple. 1900.

I have to give you the remainder of this book title from the title page. After 1636 it continues: "To which is added Genealogies of Temple Families Settling in Reading, Mass., Chester Co., PA., Ayletts, Va., Galway, N.Y., and Elsewhere. Also Brief Genealogies of Families Connected by Marriage with the Foregoing. Viz.: Eames, Case, Welch, Kellum, Campbell, Wilson, Hiatt, Spray, Cook, Tredway, and Murdock." The book begins with the legend that the family descends from Leofric, Earl of Mercia, the Consort of Lady Godiva of Coventry. In 1279, Temple Hall an estate in Leicester Co., England is shown by public records to be held by Henry de Temple. The actual record begins with Abraham in Salem, Mass., in 1636 and brings the family down to the late 1800's. Some descendants settled across north LA from Monroe to Shreveport. Many other families are also followed. Old records are quoted but the locations are not given. Abstracts of English wills of Temple Testators is a valuable addition. Some past owner has made penciled corrections in the margins, which could prove to be quite valuable. Size 9½ x 6½. Hard Bound. 316 Pages. Indexed. Full name index only for Temple name. An added attraction to this book is an Index to Places.

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TITLE: THE COURT CIRCLES OF THE REPUBLIC OR THE BEAUTIES AND CELEBRITIES OF THE NATION; ILLUSTRATING LIFE AND SOCIETY UNDER EIGHTEEN PRESIDENTS: DESCRIBING THE SOCIAL FEATURES OF THE SUCCESSIVE ADMINISTRATIONS FROM WASHINGTON TO GRANT. By Mrs. E. F. Ellet. 1869.

Each of the 21 chapters in this book covers the administration of a president. The author describes the drawing room circles, the prominent statesmen and leading ladies, the brilliant belles and distinguished visitors, the principal entertainments, fashionable styles of dress, manners, etiquette, anecdotes, and

incidents of the administrations of each of the presidents, from Washington to Grant. There are lovely steel engravings of original portraits. In the Preface, the author says, "So vast a variety of sources of information have been consulted for this work, that a list of them would be tedious..." She also mentions letters, journals and valuable family papers, but fails to give a single source. This lack of sources is a great loss as is the lack of an index. Size 9 x 6½. Hard Bound. 586 pages. No Index.

TITLE: BENJAMIN FRANKLIN by John S. C. Abbott. 1876

This biography of Benjamin Franklin is the 12th book in a series called "American Pioneers and Patriots". The author has endeavored to give an accurate account of Franklin's character and the great struggle in which he took part, which secured the Independence of the Colonies, and led to the formation of the United States. No sources are given but a few footnotes indicate the extensive use of Franklin's works and his autobiography. Size 5 x 7½. Hard Bound. 373 pages. No Index.

TITLE: RECOLLECTIONS AND LETTERS OF GENERAL ROBERT E. LEE by his son, Captain Robert E. Lee, Jr. 1904 1924 reprint.

His son gives an intimate access to the heart of Robert E. Lee. He shows him in his home life through his own memories of his father and also from letters General Lee wrote to various members of his family and to friends. Capt. Lee begins with his first remembrance of his father when he was about 3 years old, and ends with his father's death. In between, he gives a detailed account of the Lee family in their various homes. There are delightful stories of the family and the family pets, especially the dog so devoted to General Lee that he was allowed to attend church with the family. In letters written to and by him, General Lee's military career and the war are dealt with from the family point of view which is quite different from the military view usually given. Size 5½ x 8½. Hard Bound. Indexed.

TITLE: THE MAGAZINE OF AMERICAN HISTORY WITH NOTES AND QUERIES. Edited by John Austin Stevens. October 1881.

This volume is divided into seven parts: historical; biographical; translation; notes, queries and replies; reprints; editor's chronicle; and literary notices. It deals with the Revolutionary War and contains a beautiful 1781 fold-out map of the siege of Yorktown. There are accounts of naval campaigns and the diary of a French Officer and a journal of the Yorktown siege by another French officer. This is a most interesting quarterly.

TITLE: THE DESCENDANTS OF VALENTINE KIRKPATRICK. Compiled by Willett Douglas Kirkpatrick.

The first chapter of this book deals with the life of Valentine Kirkpatrick and his wife, Martha McMurray, and their life in Cabarrus Co., NC. They had 10 children: James, Eleanor, Sarah, Robert, William, Margaret, Francis, John Dodd, Laird and Zeno. Zeno died in infancy and Sarah never married, but the other 8 children all married and reared families. Robert and his sister, Sarah, remained in NC with their parents, but the remainder of the children migrated to the Butler/Lowndes county area of AL. The remainder of this book documents the life and descendants of each child. generation by generation, from the 1700's down to the present, when possible. The descendants have spread into most of the 50 states and many foreign countries. Each chapter is followed by documentation notes. 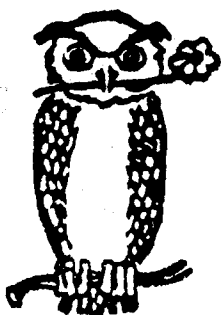

(Here is a list of "Don'ts" to add to the Genealogists guideline for winning friends and influencing people.)

Don't mark in public records or remove materials for your own use. This should go without saying, but there are still people who do such things.

Don't leave all those records in your files to mold and decay...or be thrown out when you are no longer around. Put them in tangible forms today!

Don't let the past replace the present. The knowledge of the past helps us appreciate the present. Yet, the avid researcher may become so engrossed in yesterday, that he loses today. Searches for ancestors past are abstractions.. recorded in mere symbols for those who once lived and smelled the flowers. Enjoy today while there's still time. Make your own mark on the face of the world so you may someday be worth reading about.
