## GETTING THE MOST FROM YOUR SOCIETY

When a society is first organized, it is difficult for its members to understand their role in the genealogical field. Most members feel their only interest is finding their ancestors and do not realize that what they do, both as an organization and an individual affects other researchers. Wrong! Everything we do impacts others in the field.

The officers, directors, and "the oldtimers" have a responsibility to all members (and to themselves) to teach good research techniques.

Why us? Because we care. We care enough to accept the work that goes with being an officer or committee chairman. We care what a new member learns because we know that each time a member learns something—we learn. We know the meaning of sharing our knowledge and we know that through these sharing experiences, we will benefit ourselves in furthering our own research.

But caring is not enough. We must put our knowledge and abilities into action. We want our society to grow, we want our members to benefit by being a member, and we want to retain them as members. So how are we going to do this?

First, recognize that you have different types of members:

1. Those who live locally (only about 10% of these will be loyal workers.)
2. Those who will come around "once in awhile". Perhaps! We'll take a look at these people later.
3. Those who live outside of the area.
4. Those who live in other states and have ancestors in your area.

So what should your society offer? Here are some suggestions:

1. Classes in good research techniques—for both beginners and advanced students.

Who can teach these classes? Anyone who can read. There are many "how-to" books on the market today. Plus, there are books that touch on just about every phase of genealogy from "how to begin" to "genetics in genealogy".

A book has just recently been published, On Teaching Genealogy, by Fran Carter (Published by Heritage Quest). This book does not tell you what to teach, but it does describe in detail "how to teach". It is a wonderful guide for those who are willing to step forward and teach. Your society should be offering at least two classes each year.

Who is going to benefit the most from teaching a class? The instructor. Teaching a class forces you to learn things you might not have learned otherwise.

2. Guest speakers at the society meetings.

This should be an extension of your formal classroom lessons. Who can you get as interesting speakers? Try county officials (the keepers of the records—Clerk of the Court, County Recorder, and so on). How about morticians, cemetery sextons, archivists, church officials, historians, or members with knowledge of a genealogical subject—just to name a few. Get more ideas from other society's newsletters.

3. Workshops.

Workshops are being held all over the country now. Take advantage of

them. If you can't attend, hold one of your own. Unfortunately, statistics have proven it is the "local" members that do not support a workshop. If you are to learn "where the records are", it is necessary to attend every workshop you can.

I often hear "I didn't attend because the registration fee was so high". In fact, the cost per each session is approximately \$3.00 to \$5.00. There is not one of us that wouldn't pay \$10.00 for any one record. Then why not spend half that much to learn where the record may be located. You might even learn where two records are kept.

#### 4. Periodical.

If your society is not publishing some type of periodical, whether a quarterly or semi-annual publication, now is the time to start. Take advantage of the many societies that will exchange your publication for theirs.

If you are exchanging, as a member, you should read every periodical that comes to your society.

Let me tell you the advantage I learned by doing this. I looked (for twenty years) for the marriage of my mother's paternal grandparents, John McGinley and Rachael Miller.

I knew they were probably married in Indiana from the birth of their first two children and from her obituary. But I had exhausted every clue as to where the marriage took place. Twice I had been to Indianapolis looking through the wonderful marriage indexes at the Indiana State Historical Society, but not all Indiana counties were indexed. During my third Indiana trip (to the Ft. Wayne Library) I searched about 20 counties. Nothing.

A week after my return, I went to my society library (in St. Joseph, MO-I have since moved to Kansas City). My friend, Jackie, went to the shelf and started looking through a periodical called SYCAMORE LEAVES published by the Wabash Valley Genealogical Society, Terre Haute, Indiana.

She turned to me and said, "Joyce, here is a marriage on a McGinley. Do you want it?"

Well, of course I wanted it. I wanted every McGinley I could find.

"Which McGinley?, I asked.

"John McGinley and Rachael Miller", she said.

"Sure, Jackie..."

(She knew who I was looking for). I thought she was joking.

"Come see for yourself", she said.

I went around the table and there it was! Published in a periodical! I was ecstatic! I jumped up and down. I hugged Jackie. I cried. After all of these years of searching, I had found it! She had found it.

Do you think I will love the people forever who work on that publication? You bet I will. And there are similar situations waiting for you. Read them all.

#### 5. Newsletter.

What's the purpose of a newsletter? It is the primary means of communication, not only with your members, but with others who could be prospective members. It must project the image you want others to see about your organization. The newsletter should be used to the fullest extent to provide information to and about your members.

The newsletter and the periodical are the basic benefits of "out of town" members. They will be wanting vital records and other information published in the periodical. But, they will drop their membership after they have gleaned everything they need from your area.

So how can you keep their membership? By producing an outstanding and

informative newsletter. They will stay members just to receive it.

What should be included? The following are just a few suggestions:

1. Time and Place of Meetings. Include business, board, committee, workshops, study groups, classes, and special events.
2. Program Schedule. Guest speakers, topic, board recommendations, items that need to be voted on by membership, elections, etc.
3. Board of Directors. Actions and recommendations.
4. Treasurer's Report. (At least periodically). Every member has a right to know how the money is spent.
5. Introduction of New Members. List the surnames they are searching- and include happenings to current members.
6. Pedigree Charts or Ahnentafels. (If not published in your periodical).
7. Summary of Lectures by Guest Speakers. For the benefit of those who could not attend the meeting- and especially for members who live out of the area.
8. News from Other Societies. (Workshops, special publications, legislative action, etc.).
9. Membership Fee. (And how to become a member.).
10. Names and Address of Officers. And committee people. Address of the society. At least one phone number of someone to contact for questions about the society.
11. Special Instructions. (What do you need from your members? How do you want queries submitted? How do you want charts submitted?)
12. Material from Members. What material would you like to solicit from members, such as books, microfilm, money contributions, bible records, articles for periodical, special collections, etc.).

#### 6. Surname Index.

Ask members to submit an Ancestor Chart and begin a Surname Index. This index should be published at least every two years. This will give members an opportunity to seek out others who are working on the same surname or in the same area. They can then work together.

#### 7. Study Groups.

One of the best ways to give individual attention to members is through study groups. These groups can be geared to the interest of the members, such as computer interest groups, ethnic interest groups (Germany, England, Scotland, etc.), state or region interest groups (Missouri, North Carolina, New England, etc.).

#### 8. Participation.

There are always members who show up for meetings, but who seldom participate in any position or assignment. There can be several reasons why they can not participate. Individuals who have health problems should not be expected to do much. But in my experience, many of the others do not participate simply because they are not asked.

Define very closely the tasks that need to be performed. Break down those tasks and ask several people to assist. When several people share in the work, no one person has to do a lot. I was once told that a "good" president does nothing...except see that everyone else does their job well. Stress to your members that by working on projects, they will learn from each other. Someone just discovered a new book has been published and shares that information. Someone just found a primary source and explains the procedure of locating it. It is an ever-learning process. And, it can be FUN!

Organizations that assign jobs or titles to various members on an annual basis soon learn that these jobs become difficult to fill from year to



year. Instead of trying to anticipate, identify, and accomplish every job on an annual basis, keep the overall duties of committee chairpersons to setting goals and policies. Then, as work needs to be done, approach individuals who may be able to help.

Individual members of a genealogical society must be encouraged to participate. A letter asking for help from a member can be one approach, but a letter can easily be ignored and a response is not always imperative. A phone call is better, but it is still easy for someone to find excuses not to participate. An effective president knows that a personal visit to a member is the best approach to ask for participation.

If you are going to ask a person to help, keep these items in mind:

1. Keep the request simple.
2. Define the task clearly.
3. Be Sincere.
4. Be honest.
5. Make the person feel important.
6. Ask for the person's advice on how to do the job.

In Summary: How do you get the most from your society? By giving yourself, your talent, your time...because you care. If not, you are not getting out of your society what you deserve. Caring is sharing; sharing is learning; learning attains your goal of finding that next generation. Just as we set our goals to find great-grandpa (and we won't give up on that), we should also do everything we can to preserve and maintain our records for tomorrow's genealogical researchers.

## BOOK REVIEWS

TITLE: THE DESCENDANTS OF JOHN TISDALE (1614-1675) COLONIAL MASSACHUSETTS.  
By Robert Tisdale.

John Tisdale was born in County Yorkshire, England to Thomas and Ruth Tisdale and baptised at Ripon 7 Nov 1614. About 1636, John came to Old Massachusetts Bay Colony and settled on a grant at Green Harbor. He married about 1640, Sarah Walker, who was also born in England in 1616, and had arrived in the Colony in 1633. John was quite active in the arrairs of his community, serving as Constable of Duxbury. He later moved to Taunton, where he was a selectman and representative of the city to the Plymouth General Court. John was killed by Indians in 1675 at the age of 61. John and Sarah had eight children, many of whom lived into their 70's.

From this beginning generation by generation, the author follows the family down to a 12th generation birth in New York on 19 Jan 1971. The numbering system used makes it easy to follow. Many of the people are given real substance by personal letters and family tales. Many documents are referred to and quoted from, but regretfully there is no documentation as such. There are over 1,000 entries of the Tisdale name plus 787 allied families. If you are a Tisdale, you need this book in your library. Size 9½ x 6½. Hard Bound. 237 pages. Full name index.

Originally published in 1886, this is a 1971 reprint reproduced as nearly the same as the original as possible. These sketches are a combination of local history and reminiscence that recreates the spirit and atmosphere of times past. There is a delightful description of an Indian princess. The notices of river boats gives us a very good picture of travel and commerce on the river in the 1820's. Among subjects covered are the early settlement of Mobile, the War of 1812, city fires and city politics and politicians. On the lighter side, the anecdotes are delightful insights into the practical jokes and humor of our ancestors. Size 8½ x 5½. Soft Bound. 66 Pages. No Indes.

This index was compiled from the original hand written records in the Louisiana State Land Office and covers the following parishes: all of Bossier, Caddo, DeSoto, Natchitoches, Red River, Sabine and Webster; most of Bienville and Claiborne; northern two-thirds of Vernon; and the western portion of Rapides and Winn. Using this index, the records can be ordered from the State Land Office. The records in the Tract Books give the township, range, section, portion of section, by whom acquired, price paid, date of transaction and certificate number. TITLE: MARRIAGES AND OBITUARIES FROM THE NEW ORLEANS CHRISTIAN ADVOCATE 1851-1860 WITH COMPLETE INDEX. VOLUME 1. By E. M. and Ema L. Tipton.

Prior to the Civil War, Methodism was the largest Protestant denomination in the United States. They published the weekly newspaper Christian Advocate, followed by the name of the city or sponsoring Conference. It carried primarily religious news, but was designed and edited as a complete newspaper. In this area, it carried marriage and death notices, not only of Methodist members of the sponsoring Conference, but also non-members and important regional figures. The marriage notices were usually sent in by the minister who performed the ceremony, giving the names of the bride, groom, minister, date, place of the ceremony, and sometimes, the parents of the bride. The obituaries were sent in by ministers, family members, or a friend of the deceased. The name of the deceased, date and place of birth, death and marriage, survivors and parents are usually given. Some of the obituaries are quite lengthy and the writer sometimes forgot to mention these details or the printer ran out of space before he got to them, so some are more informative than others. The New Orleans publication was designed to serve the Louisiana, Mississippi, Alabama and Arkansas Conferences. However, other places are also mentioned. If you have a Methodist ancestor, you may find a marriage or obituary here which cannot be found anywhere else. Size 11 x 8½. Hard Bound. 346 pages. Full name index.

Part one of this book covers the English background of the Etheridge family from the first records in 1500 to 1612. Part Two is divided into four chapters, each one covering a generation of the family in America. Chapter four of this part pertains to Caleb Etheridge (1721-1791) of the 4th generation. Part three deals with the eight sons of Caleb and his wife, Agnes Clark Etheridge, and is divided into eight family groups, one for each son of this the 5th generation. Each family group is taken down in both the male and female lines to the 11th generation.

Part Four of this book is titled "Other Etheridges" and gives detailed information, some down to the 11th generation on Etheridge families for whom there is no known connection. It also contains lists of Confederate Military Records from Alabama, Georgia and Louisiana, gathered from both State and National Archives.

Many family pictures and maps add interest. Deeds, wills and family letters are scattered throughout, and are printed in script, which makes them easy to identify. Full documentation is given making this book a must for all Etheridge researchers and allied families. Size 11 x 8½. Soft Bound. 408 Pages. Full name index.

Beginning with the Kilgores of Britain, Scotland and America, the author picks up Thomas Kilgore, Sr., in Chapter 2. His obituary in 1822, gave his age as 110 years, making him born in 1712. His birth place is unknown. The first record found of him is on road duty in 1764 in Orange Co., NC at the age of 52. In 1775, at the age of 63, he first traveled into what is now Robertson Co., TN, and in 1779, became the first settler in this area, where he erected Kilgore's Station, a fort to protect settlers. The author grew up on the land originally granted to Thomas in TN and her tales of Thomas' early times in TN make very interesting reading. Thomas had sons Thomas, Jr; Charles; Johnston; and a daughter Lydia Ann. A chapter is devoted to each child and their descent is brought down to 1991. This family history is well documented and illustrated with original documents and many lovely photographs. There are appendices explaining the division of counties and abstracts of NC and TN deeds. A few of the many families marrying into the Kilgore line are Adams, Ayers, Baggett, Byram, Campbell, Crabtree, Dance, Durrett, Eldridge, Ellis, Fisher, Freeland, Gainer, Hancock, Hughes, Jackson, Jones, Kelton, Krisle, Landon, Luckenbaugh, Martin, Moncrief, Norman, Offutt, Payne, Price, Reppeto, Robertson, Salomone, Strother, Tate, Turrentine, Wilson and Yates. Maps of Ireland are included showing ancient provinces, kingdoms and baronies. Administrative divisions are explained. Pictures of hundreds of Arms are given. The title gives the dates as 1794-1900, however, I found marriage dates as late as 1981. Each entry gives the name, name of spouse, date and place of marriage. The author has arranged these marriages into family units alphabetically giving each family a number, making it very easy to follow a family back to the immigrant ancestors or forward through collateral lines. A history of the Madeleine Island tells you when people came, where they came from, and in many cases, when they departed and where they went. Most of them went into Canada, but many also came down into the New England states of the U. S. Also included is a short biography of the Roman Catholic Clergy of the Islands, a short history of the present Catholic parishes of the Islands, with pictures of the churches, a bibliography, a list of Acadian families and a list of English, Irish and Italian families. This book is a valuable asset to Acadian researchers and anyone with Catholic ancestors in the Madeleine Islands. Size 8½ x 11. Soft Bound. 326 pages.
