## LIST OF PHYSICIANS REGISTERED WITH BOSSIER PARISH (AS REQUIRED BY ACT 31 OF 1882)

Act 31, of 1882 apparently required physicians to register with the Clerk of Courts office and list their full name, where and when attended school and other pertinent information. Registration of Physicians had occurred prior to this in Bossier Parish, but that listing is contained in a book marked Misc. Records Book A. That registration began about 1877 and continued until 1882 when a separate book was began.

This index only includes those registrations which occur in the 1882 Physicians Register book. James Franklin Mooty registered a total of three times before he got all the information complete. The first time he only listed his initials, the second time only the parish where he began practice and then returned a third time to register again. George Arthur Wise registered twice, the second time because the first he had only listed his initials on the application.

The listings contain; NAME OF PHYSICIAN, where born, when born, school attended, when began practice, where began practice, when registered at Bossier Parish, page # of book. After 1891 a copy of their certification is attached, and it only lists information therein, and no more.

**AARON**, the son of Amram and Jochebed, and the elder brother of Moses and Miriam (Num. xxvi. 59; xxxiii. 39). He was a Levite, and is first mentioned in Ex. iv. 14 as one who could "speak well." He was appointed by Jehovah to be the Interpreter and "Mouth" (Ex. iv. 16) of his brother Moses, who was "slow of speech;" and accordingly he was not only the organ of communication with the Israelites and with Pharaoh (Ex. iv. 30; vii. 2), but also the actual instrument of working most of the miracles of the Exodus (Ex. vii. 19, etc.). Aaron was consecrated by Moses to the new office of the high priesthood. The solemnity of the office and its entire dependence for sanctity on the ordinance of God, were vindicated by the death of his sons, Nadab and

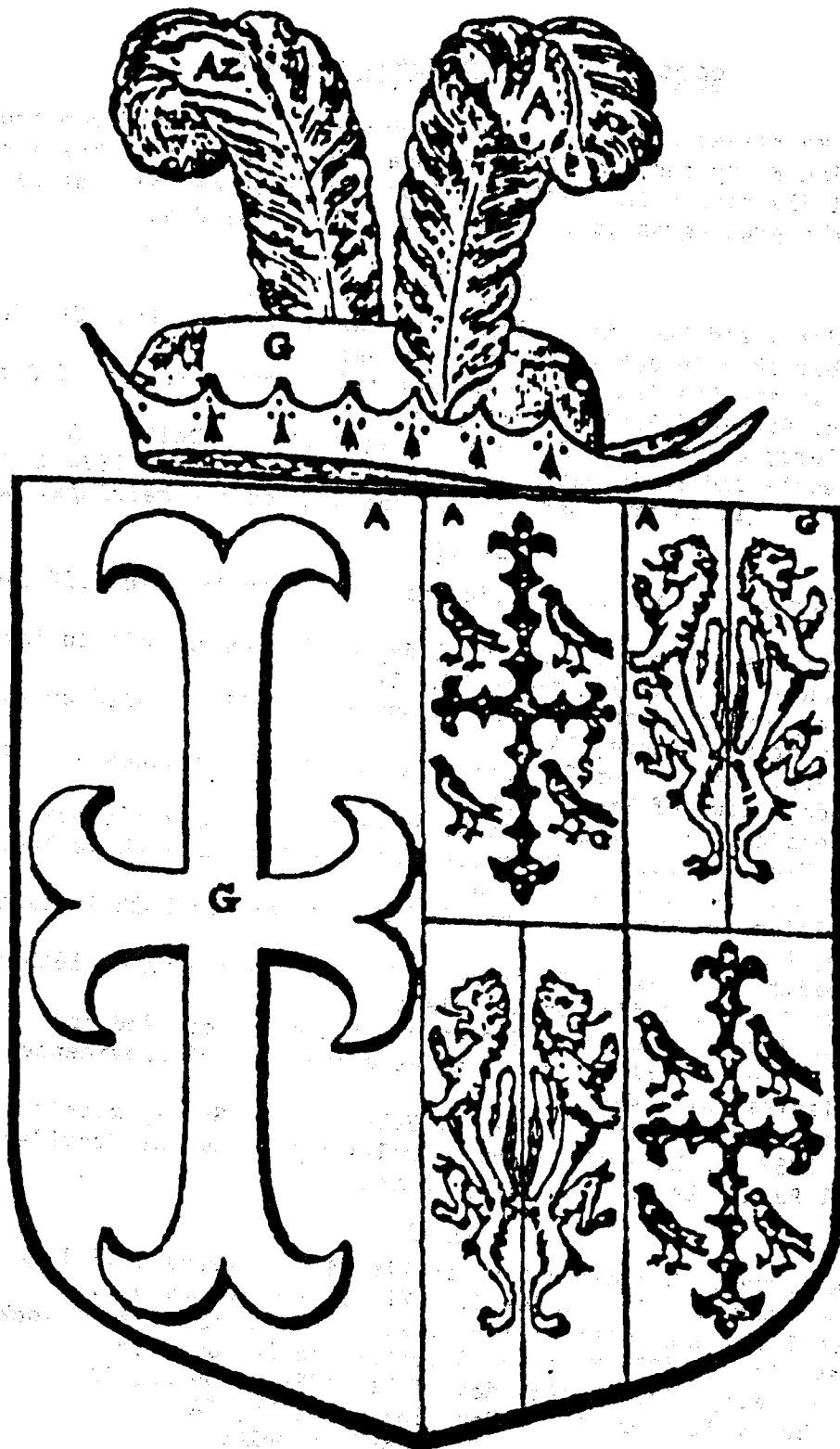

The St. Joseph A.M.E. Church Cemetery consists of decedents of African-American ancestry and is on acreage near the east bank of Bayou Bonne Idee within a few yards from the St. Joseph A.M.E. Church, 14756 Rosenwald Highway, Bonita, Morehouse Parish, Louisiana. It is reached by traveling north on Wilmot Highway 165 toward the Village of Bonita and by turning right on Rosenwald Highway (Louisiana Highway 599). After passing the St. Joseph Church and taking the first road to the right, one passes behind the defunct Rosenwald School and arrives at the St. Joseph A.M.E. Church Cemetery.

The St. Joseph A.M.E. Church and Cemetery, affectionately known as "St Joe," were formally established in 1874. Dr. James W. Pratt sold for seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) in cash to Mr. Harry Roberts, acting as the President of the Board of Trustees of St. Joseph A.M.E. Church, and to his successors in office five acres more or less on which the "Colored St. Joseph A.M.E. Church South" and gravesite already stood. This document was signed on January 8, 1874 by Messrs. Pratt and Roberts and witnessed by B. C. Jacobs and L. D. Williams. It was recorded on January 10, 1874 by Henry W. Naff, Deputy Recorder and ex-officio Notary Public, in Morehouse Parish's Notarial Book "J," on pages 470 and 471 and is on file at the Bastrop, Morehouse Parish, Louisiana, Court House.

Researched and recorded data as read in **Part I** on December 17, 1994, May 29, and May 30, 1995 by Mrs. Isabelle Woods, 2016 Surrey Lane, Bossier City, Louisiana. **Part II** are additional burials known to exist (based on funeral programs) but have no headstones. **Part III** are probable burials in this cemetery based on the fact that the decedents' funeral services were held at the St. Joseph A.M.E. Church.

This cemetery is not well-maintained. Consequently, it is highly probable that many headstones were neither accessible nor visible nor recorded on May 29, and 30, 1995.

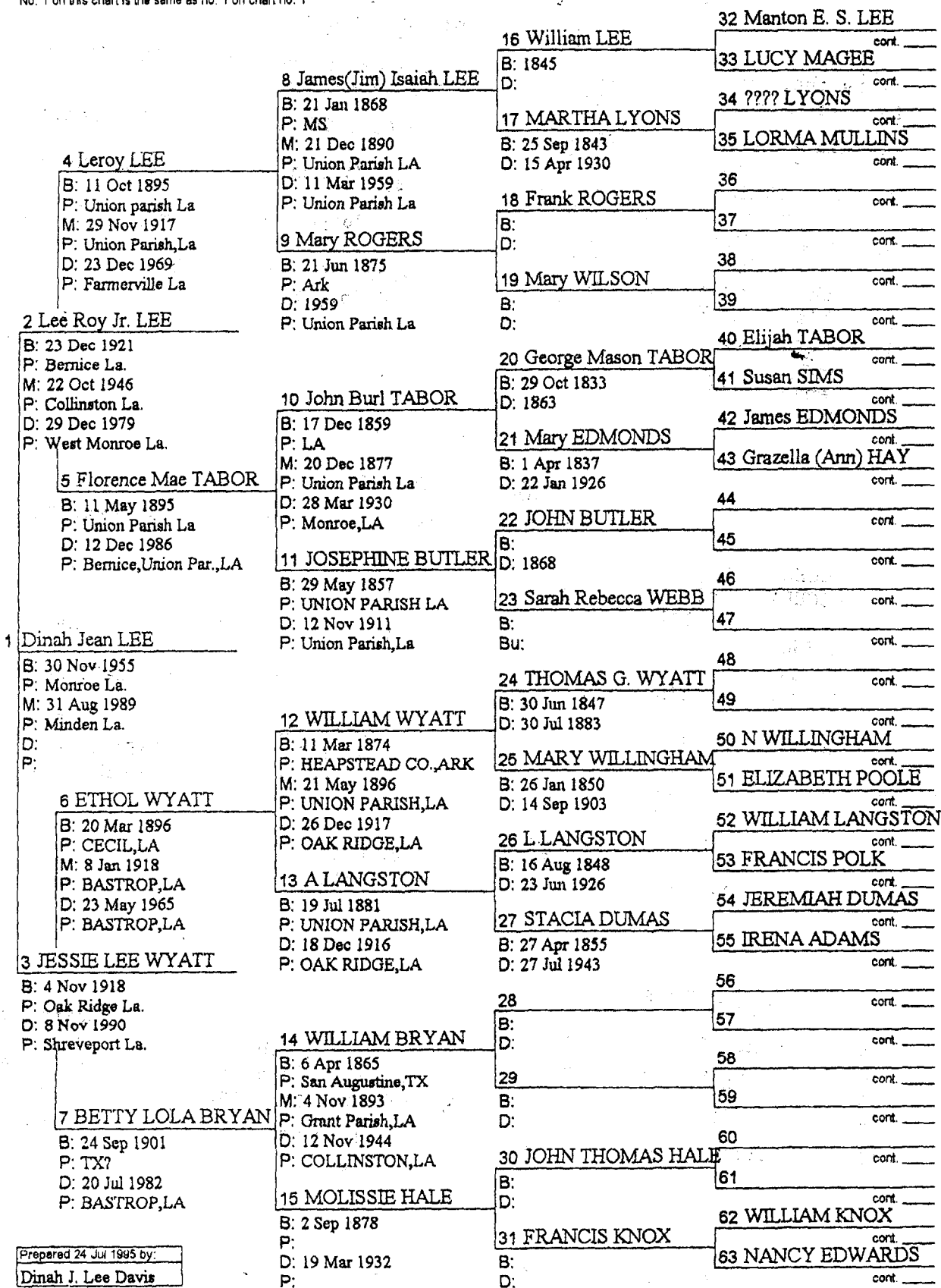
