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PRESIDENT'S LETTER

Dear Members and Friends:

Our June program was one of the most interesting and informative talks ever. Carroll Goynes reported on the new theories on the origins of the Melungeons, the mysterious dark people who have lived in the Appalachian region of the United States for centuries. Carroll and his wife, Betty, have gathered evidence that people from the Mediterranean regions had lived in North America for hundreds of years before the continent was "discovered" by western Europeans. He cited historical reports made by Indians to early explorers of people who lived in stone houses and he described a site where the remnants of such stone buildings were found. He mentioned ancient stone inscriptions found in this country that resemble old Celtic and Phoenician writings. He presented lists of Indian words that compare to Turkish equivalents, ancient and modern.

The research into the Melungeons continues. Carroll talked about DNA comparisons of the Melungeons and the Turks that are being conducted this summer. Carroll has been approached to co-author a book on the latest linguistic findings. Carroll and Betty are doing fascinating work. We look forward to hearing all the breaking news.

The Board of the Ark-La-Tex Genealogical Association decided about a year ago that because we had presented seminars on Texas and Louisiana research that it was time to present one on Arkansas. Desmond Walls Allen is the leading expert on genealogical work in Arkansas and was the obvious choice as speaker. It was only after we had started advertising the seminar as an Arkansas show, that we realized that Desmond Allen had much more to offer than just a talk on Arkansas for this seminar.

Half of the day for the seminar will be devoted to Desmond Allen's "Creative Problem Solving", a workshop that will show participants how to examine previous work, to organize materials and then to develop a research plan. This step by step process will help us solve the "brick wall" problems that all of us have. I did not realize that so many people would express such enthusiasm over Desmond Allen's "Map Resources for Genealogists" either. It is reportedly an excellent discussion, as well, that should appeal to intermediate and advanced researchers.

All of the folks who have ties to Arkansas--and that is almost everyone of us around here--want to hear Desmond Allen speak on "Research in Arkansas" of course. Desmond will discuss the special resources available and the specific research strategies for genealogical work in Arkansas.

The August Seminar should be a fine day. Early registrations having been high. Seating is limited. I urge you to get your registration in now if you do not want to miss the show.

Phillip Troller, born 1781, died 5 November 1865, was a Corporal who served three years in the service of His Britannic Majesty in the King German 3rd Regiment. (24 Feb 1816). His wife is unknown. His children are listed as follows:

He was born in Alsace and taught in the Kolman school. In 1853, the young couple migrated to Canada, either Sarnia or Walpool, Canada, where he followed the trade of carpenter. Several years later he accepted a call to teach in St. Paul's school in Ft. Wayne, IN. Four years later they moved to Cooper's Grove, IL, where he continued his teaching profession.

MICHAEL FEAZEL-THE IMMIGRANT

(Mrs. Gritzbaugh, who is a member of the DAR, has written a correction in her article that may help other people in establishing their DAR records.)

The earliest record I have been able to locate on Michael Feazel was from the passenger list of the "Phoenix", which shows a Michael Vusel. F's and V's are often common errors in the German language. I found it interesting that George Snider (or Taylor) of Shenandoah County came to America from the Rhineland in 1749, under the auspices of the Quakers and settled in the German region near Philadelphia. George Snider was the owner of land with our Feazel ancestor.

Shenandoah County court records show that Phillip Sonner had joint ownership of land with Michael Feazel and his brother, Sebastian Feazle. Bk. Q, p 13, dated 13 July 1807 reads in part "...tract of land lying and being on the branches of Funks Mill run it being half of Moierty of a certain tract which was formerly granted by Deed from the late land propertors off of Northern Neck the 15th. July 1766 to Phillip Sonner, Michael and Sebastian Feazle (as joint tenants) Michael Feazle departed this life intestate leaving no will and his heirs to wit: John Feazle, Michael Feazle, Jun., Martin Feazle and GEORGE FEAZLE conveyed all right and title by their several deeds to Jacob Feazle also one of the heirs..."

One record of Michael and Elizabeth Feazel is in a land survey dated 6 May 1755, when 524 acres of land in Frederick County, VA. "including where they lived" was surveyed for Michael Feazel and his brother Sebastian and George Snider (or Taylor).

There is one record dated 16 Nov 1781, signed by Alexander Hite testifying that Mr. Michael Feafsel gave 180 lbs of beef to the army during the Revolution, and payment was granted at the rate of 24 shillings per pound. There is also a record that Sebastian Feazel furnished food for the army.

In 1797, Michael and Elizabeth Feisel of Rockingham County sold a lot in Woodstock to Henry Dinges. It is not probably that this is our ancestor, as Michael, Jr.'s will dated Dec 1795 states that his parents are deceased. This is evidently the Michael Feazel who married Elizabeth Bush in 1783 of a different Feazel family.

Some historians have incorrectly written that our Michael Feazel was a son of Killian Fissel. "Emigrants from the Palatinate to the American Colonies in the 18th Century" by Fredrich Krebs, edited with an introduction by Milton Robincom, Norristown, Pa., German Society, 1953. Killian married Christiana (This is Cullen and Tina). Killian was born in 1699, but I find no record of his death in York City, Pa., where he lived. He did have a son named Hanns Michael, who was born 5 Jan 1735. This is not our ancestor. This man lived in Paradise Twp., in New York City with his wife, Anna. His will is dated 1809 and proved 1810.

Killian came to America in 1742 with his wife and their eleven children on the "Loyal Judith" and there are only ten children listed.

German families often called children by their middle name. It is unknown to me who the father of Michael Feazel and grandfather of George Feazel was. It has been proven that it was not Killian Fissel.

2. Michael Feazel, Jr. (abt 1755-Dec 1795 VA) married Christiana Hank on 5 May 1782 VA. He left a family of young children, lived in Pendleton Co., VA. Christiana sold his part of the father's estate to his brother, Jacob, in 1797. Michael, Jr., served in the Rev War and received bounty land.
3. Catherine Feazel married 29 April to John Hommon.
4. Sarah Feazel sold her share of her father's estate to her brother, Michael, Jr., in 1819. She was unmarried in 1819.
5. Susannah Feazel married Jesse Stump and was living in Hardy County in 1826.
6. Rebecca Feazel married Michael Yankey. They appear in the Highlands Co., OH census records.
7. Mary Feazel married John Hutinger.
8. Elizabeth Feazel married 16 Apr 1803 to Jonathan Lewis.
9. George (Johann Jorg) (abt 1765-aft 1833) Marriage bonds 1772-1853 show he married Margaret Pear in Shenandoah Co., VA on 13 Jan 1790. She was a daughter of Phillip Pear. Margaret was born ca 1775 and d aft 1838, when she took land with her son, Soloman Feazel. In 1797, Margaret and George were residents of Hawkins Co., TN, where some of their children were born. They seemed to move back and forth from Virginia to Tennessee, possibly because of Indians. These people were real German. They spoke in broken English. She was called "Granny" and her Bible was written in German. In 1807, he was called John George Feizle. Bible records gave his name as Johann Jorg. This was puzzling because he had a brother John of Licking Co., OH. It appears Germans have a naming pattern curious to them. Some records indicate some German families have all the children's names starting with John if they were boys and Anna if they were girls.
10. Heinrich "Henry" Feazel (abt 1769 VA-aft 1834). On 9 Aug 1802 in VA he married Susanna Hauser, who appears in IN census in later years. She was born about 1784. In 1815, they received communion at Peaked Mt. Lutheran Church.
11. Jacob Feazel (abt 1771-abt 1824 OH). On 9 Jan 1793 VA, he married Susannah Hite, who was born about 1776 and died about 1805. She was a daughter of Catharine and Alexander Hite. On 16 Jan 1806 VA he married for the second time to Mary Elizabeth Huddle (Hottel) who was born about 1785. She inherited from her father, David Huddle.
12. Martin Feazel (1774-1821 TN). On 6 Apr 1799 VA, he married Mary "Maria" Tressler (1776-1858). She moved to IN and in 1825, she married for the second time to John Jones.

LETTER FROM CIVIL SUITS

Union Parish, LA.

(Mrs. Arelia Breed, who lives in Farmerville, LA, keeps us supplied with information from the Union Parish Courthouse. This is one of the many old letters she has sent us with information relating to her husband's Heard family.)

July 7-1845

Maj. F. C. Heard
Mobile, Ala.

Sir: Your's of 7 of June has come to hand and in answer to it I will first say to you Thomas S. Heard is now at this time a corpse. The breath left his body this morning at 2 oclock. His remains will be buried early tomorrow. He died with attack of the bilous fever. Died 7th day after taking it. A sore affliction to his Grandmother & all the rest of his relatives. I would take it as a favor of you would have it noted in the Selma free press. He was born 28th September 1840. Cousin F.C. Heard I was astonish that you charge me with $\frac{1}{2}$ of G. F. Heard's bank note after talking to me as you did last spring. Was a year at that time I cald on you to no about the note & tell you of some 4 or 500\$ owein him in this parish. At that time your answer to me you would rather pay the unfortunate brothers det than to distress his widow & would I do it. I never let on to the man that was owin him. After I got back & had no doubt the note was paid long before this. I do believe yet you had forgot our conversation. When you rote this. My situation at present is very poor one to raise money at this time. The wormes destroyed my crop last year. or nearly so maid not more than half a crop of cotton. I shall ever think it a vary hard case if I have to pay $\frac{1}{2}$ of that det after given him the amount of property I have. 18 negroes to his chile & between 1000 & 1200\$ to himself. I no that his estate is worth not les than 4 or 5000\$. I now say to you you may rely on my going to see Mr. Webster in 30 days. Sooner if I can get ready & will wright to you as soon as I return & let you know what you may depend on.

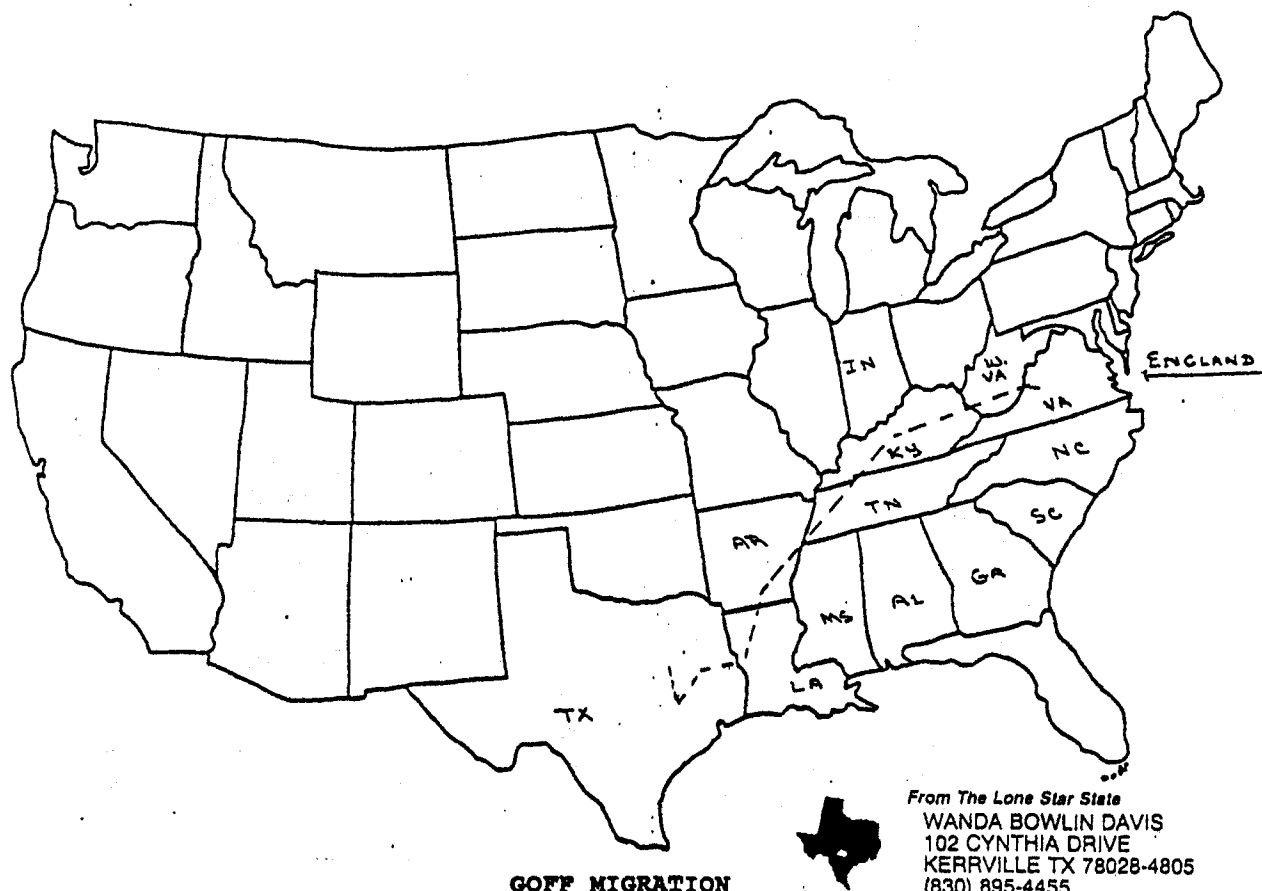

It is thought that about 10,000 of these were sent to America. Mr. Burgoyne has done extensive research in this area and written several books. This book presents in translation parts of diaries, letters and regimental records from 34 individual sources from five of the six states that rented their armies to Great Britain. The reader will experience the war in chronological order, from the Hessian departure from Germany, through the harrowing Atlantic crossing, through as many as eight years of military campaigns, and then back to Germany. This genealogy comprises two main surnames, Joiner and Ryals. These are both traced back to England, and family history is given. Data is also given on the allied families of Adams, Cadwell, Carver, Clarke/Clark, Coleman, Eason, Harrell, Long and Wright. The book is arranged so that finding ancestors and descendants is quick and easy. Biographical information is in paragraph form and children listed in chart form. Certain family lines are followed into the 1990s. I would be cautious when using this information, for example: the family on page 32 has children born 3/27/1892 and 4/15/1892; 12/2/1879 and 2/7/1880. The children in some cases are not listed in order of birth so you may find what looks like a second family structure. The locations where most recent families are domiciled is not given, so unless you are already familiar with the families, you will have some difficulties. This is a good starting place, though, so if you have these surnames, you will want to at least check the book out. 1994, size 5½ x 8, 116 pp., index, paper-bound.

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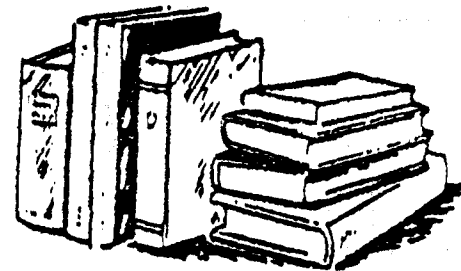
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Charles Henry Pratt
